

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we celebrate already the Second Sunday of Advent. I hope all of you had a very blessed Thanksgiving. I certainly did – I was able to spend the week of Thanksgiving with my two brothers and two sisters and I was able to celebrate the Mass on Thanksgiving Day at my home parish Our Lady of Lourdes in Ada. I hosted several family gatherings during the week for my siblings – breakfast after Mass on Thanksgiving, and dinner on Tuesday and Friday. It was good to be together and I hope your own Thanksgiving gatherings were equally fulfilling.

This past week, on November 30, we celebrated the Feast of St. Andrew, the patronal feast day of our parish. On that same day, our former bishop, Bishop Brennan was installed as the eighth Bishop of Brooklyn. That means that the Diocese of Columbus is now without a bishop! We are experiencing the “sede vacante” or the “vacant see.” As we pray for the success of Bishop Brennan’s ministry in Brooklyn, let us also pray fervently that a new bishop will soon be named to be our shepherd and to guide and lead the Diocese of Columbus.

As we prepare for the coming Solemnity of the Nativity of the Lord at Christmas, I am happy to tell you that this year will not be like last year! We will not be taking reservations or limiting Mass attendance on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day. Rather, we will have the regular schedule of Masses for the Christmas observance on December 24-25 as we did in the “pre-pandemic” days! I do want to point out that there will be no Confessions or 4:30 p.m. Mass on Saturday, December 25, because it is Christmas Day.

Please note that Wednesday of this week (December 8) is the Solemnity of the Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary and is a Holy Day of Obligation. Masses for the holy day are Wednesday at 6:30 a.m., 8:30 a.m., 12:15 p.m., and 7:00 p.m.

May this second week of Advent be a time of prayer, penance, and preparation as we await the coming of our Lord Jesus Christ.






