MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

This coming Tuesday, Jan. 18, marks the beginning of the "Week of Prayer for Christian Unity," which continues through Tuesday, Jan. 25. This is an ecumenical observance in which all Christians pray for unity among Christians of different denominations.

Years ago when I was a young priest, I served as ecumenical officer for the Diocese of Columbus, and represented the local Catholic community in various ecumenical organizations like the Metropolitan Area Church Council and the Ohio Council of Churches. In the first decades after the Second Vatican Council, such ecumenical dialogue and collaboration was a high priority. I enjoyed that work and found that dialogue often showed the differences among Christian believers to be smaller than we may have thought, and there are many things about which we agree and profess in common. The week of prayer for Christian Unity was an occasion to celebrate the not-yet complete unity that nevertheless exists among Christians of different traditions, and also to pray that "all might be one" with a real sense of hope in that possibility.

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity has not gotten much attention in the Catholic community in more recent times. I think it is important that we give this cause greater attention once again, and offer our prayers that the Body of Christ may be more united and less divided. As part of this prayer, let us especially seek the protection of the unity of our Catholic Church. At every Mass, we pray that God may not look upon our sins, but on the faith of the Church, and graciously grant her peace and unity in accordance with His will. That should be our fervent prayer during this week.

I worry that our Catholic Church, like the rest of society, is becoming more divided and polarized. This must not be allowed to happen. Unity is one of the marks of the Church. Let us pray and work for the unity of the One, Holy, Catholic and Apostolic Church, and to strengthen the bonds of communion and charity among all those who believe in Christ and follow Him.

Two things have been helping me feel less sad: one is knowing that Jesus is always close to me with His love at every moment, and the other is still taking joy in the gifts that Father Ferguson gave me for Christmas as a sign of his love for me, too.

One gift that I still have been enjoying is a cool art book titled, "The Cat in Art" (by Stefano Zuffi*). This is a book that shows cats included in all sorts of works of art in history. You know, art is a special way in which we humans try to celebrate all the beautiful aspects of the world around us, or about the beauty of life, or even to ponder the deep mysteries of the world (like, well....us cats!) As I "paw" through the pages of this art book, I've learned that many artists have included cats in their artwork. 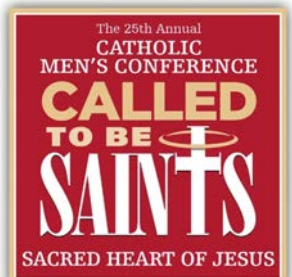

St. Andrew Conference of the Society of St. Vincent de Paul 2021 Report to the Parish

Vincentian Spirituality is the seeking to bear witness to the love of Christ through prayer, meditation on the scriptures, the teaching of the Church, through our daily lives, and in our relationship with those in need.

During the 2021 Fiscal Year (October 1, 2020 – September 30, 2021), **17** full members and **12** associate members of St. Andrew's Society of St. Vincent de Paul participated in activities to serve those in need. Members responded to **78** requests, assisting **200** individuals and family members. **Seventeen** home visits/telephone consultations were made to people living in our parish area. Parishioner's monetary and "in kind" donations enabled the St. Vincent de Paul Society to continue works of mercy and helped alleviate suffering for the needy in our local community and in the neediest areas of the diocese.

Works of Mercy

Total Dollars Spent: \$49,528

Total Volunteer Hours: 724

- **Feed the Hungry/Give Drink to the Thirsty** (2.5% of total expenditures)
 - Assist with providing free lunches to the needy at St. Lawrence Haven: **44** volunteer hours
 - Prepare sandwiches for St. Lawrence Haven's free lunch program: **\$598** plus **316** volunteer hours
 - Contribute to preparing and distribution of Thanksgiving Baskets at St. James the Less parish: **\$500**
 - Deliver food donated by parishioners to St. Stephen's Community Center: **16** volunteer hours
 - Provide food cards to those in need: **\$140**
- **Clothe the Naked** (1.4% of total expenditures)
 - Assist with serving families at the SVdP Clothing Center: **\$690** and **83** volunteer hours
 - Deliver clothes donated by parishioners to SVdP Clothing Center: **15** volunteer hours
 - Conduct parish collection drives of clothing, winter hats, gloves, blankets and linens: **48** volunteer hours
- **Shelter the Homeless** (96% of total expenditures)
 - Assist with payment of rent, utility bills and other expenses: **\$39,600** and **138** volunteer hours
 - Collaborate with Joint Organization for Inner-City Needs (JOIN) to assist families in need: **\$2,117**
 - Provide financial support to SVdP conferences in needy areas of Columbus: **\$4,850**
 - Support SVdP domestic and international disaster relief assistance: **\$1,000**
- **Visit and Comfort the Sick and Elderly** (.1% of total expenditures)
 - Send cards during Christmas and Easter to homebound parishioners and those in nursing homes: **\$33** and **5** volunteer hours
 - Visit the elderly in nursing homes: **24** volunteer hours
- **Bury the Dead**
 - Coordinate the SVdP Diocesan Council Funeral Fund: **35** volunteer hours

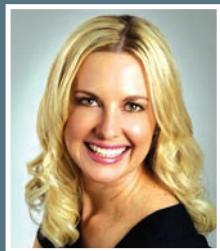

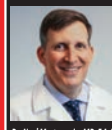
