

## MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR


Dear Parishioners:

I wish all of you a happy New Year! My New Year's celebration was somewhat subdued, as I became ill on New Year's Eve with sore throat, cough and congestion. I immediately suspected that I had been infected by the Omicron variant of COVID. However, I tested negative. I spent the weekend feeling lousy, and on Sunday, a second test came back positive. Sure enough, I had COVID. In spite of being fully vaccinated and boosted, I was infected. So, I have been quarantined all week, and am still isolated in the rectory as I write this on January 5. I wouldn't say that the year 2022 is off to a great start!

## THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN


