MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

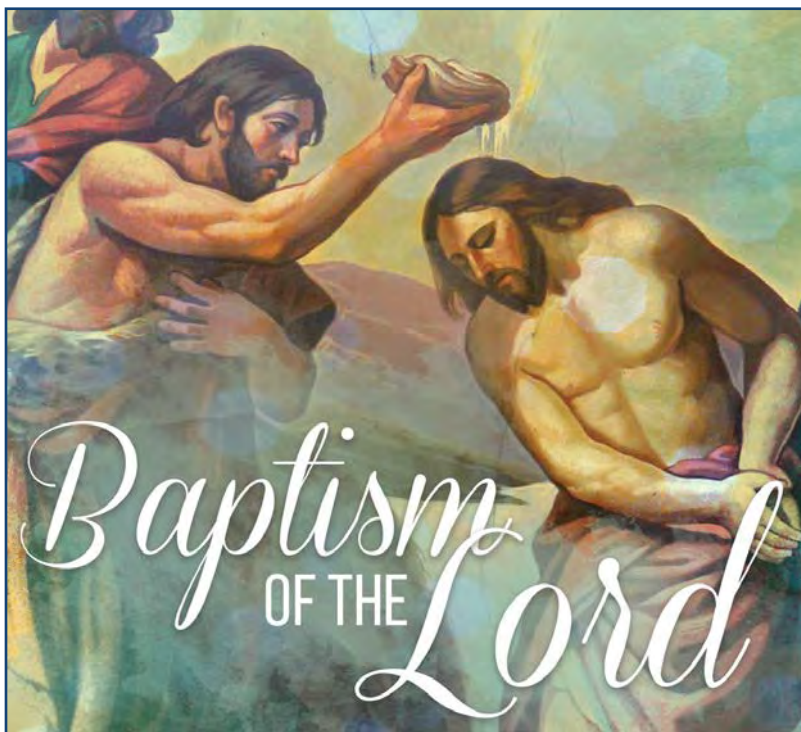
Dear Parishioners:

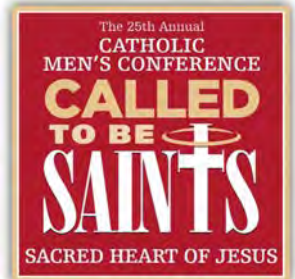
