MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

On February 27, St. Andrew Parish will be celebrating the Sacrament of Confirmation for our young Catholics completing their Christian initiation with this sacrament in which they are sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit.

These young people – eighth graders in our Parish School of Religion and St. Andrew School – have been preparing for this sacrament throughout the year and participated in a Confirmation Retreat day last Sunday. As part of their preparation, they wrote letters to me expressing their desires and hopes for this sacrament. I always enjoy their letters and find them an inspiration to me because they help me renew my own hopes and desires for holiness and to be renewed by the gifts of the Holy Spirit. In their letters to me, the confirmation candidates shared all the reasons the Catholic faith is important to them, why they want to be Confirmed, and the ways they are living out their faith of present, as well as what they hope to accomplish in the future under the guidance of the Holy Spirit.

A candidate wrote, *"I believe Christ should be one of the things I pursue. Why? Because only God can quench my thirst and soul and complete me."*

Another candidate shared, *"I discovered that God makes life easier and can bring peace in many stressful situations. As I integrated Him more in my life, I feel happier and calmer."*

One candidate explained, *"Faith to me is very important. If I am feeling overwhelmed, I pray to God that He will help me through it."*

And one candidate had this to say: *"Often I am pained to see the many issues of the world, with war, divisions, hunger, global warming, disease, and hatred...I pray that I will be able to use the resources that I am grateful to be given so I may grow up to get a job that will help solve their problems."*

Please keep our Confirmation candidates in your prayers, asking God to help them to follow the spirit's lead and do great things for God. As we have no bishop at the present time, it will be my honor to celebrate the Confirmation Mass and administer the Sacrament of Confirmation to these young disciples of Jesus Christ.

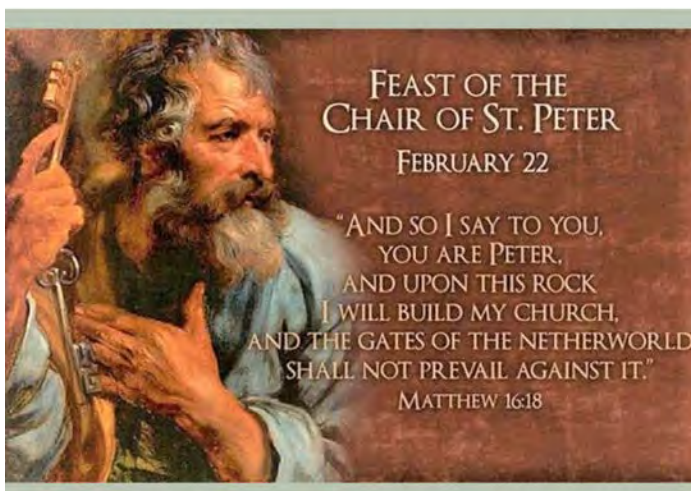

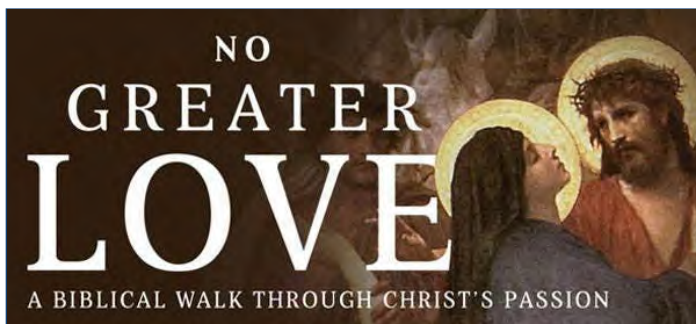
