MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This coming Wednesday, March 2, is Ash Wednesday, the beginning of the holy season of Lent. Lent is the 40-day period devoted to penance, prayer, and preparation for Easter. Most years, Lent sneaks up on me, and when Ash Wednesday arrives, I am not ready to begin the discipline of Lent. This year is different for me. Because I have been so busy and pulled in many different directions by my duties, my spiritual life has suffered. I do not devote time and attention to prayer and meditation, but often pray in a perfunctory and hurried manner. I have become distracted, undisciplined and spiritually sluggish. Perhaps you are feeling the same way.

In any case, I am looking forward to Lent this year, as a time to renew my own spiritual life through more attention and intentionality about prayer. I believe this season will give me the opportunity for renewal and will lead me to a more disciplined and more rewarding spiritual life, and indeed to a closer relationship with Christ and awareness of the presence and power of the Holy Spirit at work in me.

So, I am eager and ready to begin the Lenten journey from ashes to Easter! I hope you are eager also! Please see the schedule for Ash Wednesday Masses and the Distribution of Ashes below.

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! Today's a special day for some of the BIG kids of our parish! That's right! Later today, our eighth-grade students will be receiving a special Sacrament – Confirmation! A Sacrament is one of the most special moments of contact we can ever have with Jesus, and Confirmation is when the Holy Spirit of Jesus comes down upon a person to give him or her special "graces" – helps – to live totally for Jesus in this world. The Holy Spirit gives us graces in ALL the sacraments, but in Confirmation, the Holy Spirit gives the big kids two very specific graces: first is the grace to "evangelize" (that's a big word that simply means, "Tell others how amazing Jesus really is!"), and the second grace is to go deeper in the path of "holiness."



These two graces are really important for the big kids to receive now that they are teenagers (they're getting a lot older!). Teenagers love to talk a lot, and Jesus needs the big kids to tell their friends about how cool it is to know that you're not alone in life, that God loves us all no matter what, and that there's a whole world out there called "Heaven" that we are made for. And, teenagers, being older now, know how much tougher it can be to stay holy. As your older brothers and sisters might tell you, life gets more complicated as you get older, with lots more temptations and peer pressure and things to distract us from Heaven. Jesus wants to help the big kids to be strong and brave in making good decisions to stay holy, body and soul.

So, that's what Confirmation is all about! Some people unfortunately think that Confirmation is a "graduation" from learning about God, but that's not true. It's a new step in our relationship with Jesus, and we're always growing closer to God our whole life long. It's kind of like you right now: you're different now than you were when you were two years old. And as a cat, I'm different than I was when I first came to live with Father 13 years ago: I've gotten to know and love Father so much more over the years. Confirmation helps our big kids to keep growing in who they're designed to be: saints forever in Heaven! So, please pray for our big kids today, so that they can open their hearts to all that Jesus wants to give them! Have a "purr"-fect week!

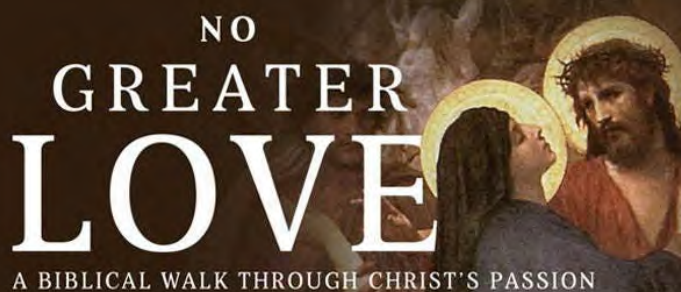

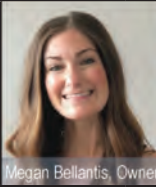
