

GETTING TO KNOW MONSIGNOR MOLONEY

To kick off Catholic Schools Week at St. Andrew School, Student Council Members interviewed Msgr. Moloney so that our school community could learn more about such an important figure in our school, parish, and the Diocese of Columbus. Each religion class submitted one question for the Student Council Members to ask during the interview and here's what they learned:

What do you enjoy most about being a Priest?

Msgr. Moloney's favorite thing about being a priest is offering Mass. He said, "It is the main thing I do. It is the high point of my day."

Did you have a favorite priest growing up?

"I had several but the one I admired most was my pastor between 9th and 10th grade, Msgr. Joseph McGlynn."

What do you enjoy most about being a Priest?

Msgr. Moloney enjoys celebrating Mass every day and also preaching.

At what age did you know you wanted to be a Priest?

He knew he wanted to be a priest at a very young age. He said, "Before I was ever in school, around 4 years old, I knew I wanted to be a priest when I grew up."

What is your biggest accomplishment in life?

"A big part of my work at the Diocese of Columbus has been work in protecting children, responding to abuse and our policies for that. I have been doing that work in one way or another for over 20 years. I think that the Diocese of Columbus has done a good job of that and I would cite that as an accomplishment of mine. And although I consider it an accomplishment, it is also the most difficult."

Was there a specific instance/situation that made you think, "yeah, I know I want to be a priest!"? What was it?

Msgr. Moloney knew he wanted to be a priest when he was just a young boy, but he remembers a priest who visited his church when he was in middle school, and this priest made a lasting impact on him. The priest told several stories about his life as a priest and reflected on times when he helped people at critical times in their lives. He ended each story saying that if that was the only thing he ever did as a priest, it was worthwhile. To Msgr. Moloney, hearing this was incredibly impactful and inspiring.

What is your favorite thing about working at a parish with a school?

Msgr. Moloney said, "The school adds SO MUCH to the life of the parish." He shared that he truly enjoys the school kids being at Mass and participating at Mass. He said, "Having kids involved at Mass is very inspiring to people. I really enjoy when we have All School Mass because having students be readers and involved in other ways such as altar servers is very inspiring." He also mentioned that he enjoys things

George Washington helped to free our country from the King of England (George III) and to make it a Republic, like it is today. It's interesting that this very day in England, the current Queen, Elizabeth II, is celebrating being the Queen there for 70 years! That's a long time! like The Passion Play which is performed by the 8th graders every year. He said things like that "are so inspiring to the adult members of our parish."

How many hours outside of Mass do you spend with Jesus?

"I hope He is always with me. That is what I strive for. But it is in the Mass that I have the closest encounter with Christ. That is when we partake in His Body and Blood; when we hear His Word, when we are gathered together." Msgr. Moloney said, "I ask Him during Mass to stay with me all day, and I hope that He does."

How has being a priest/monsignor changed over the course of your ministry?

"The biggest change for priests, especially in the Diocese of Columbus is that there are fewer and fewer of us and because of that, we have more and more work and at times, we get stretched very thin." Msgr. Moloney gave the example of his first assignment after he was ordained which was at St. Peter in Columbus. There were between 800 and 900 families in the parish and they did not have a school, but they had three full-time priests. As time has gone on, the priest distribution has become less and less. He said, "Right now I really have two full-time jobs." He mentioned that many parish priests are in charge of multiple parishes.

Who has had the biggest influence on your faith development?

"My mother and grandmother were both very influential when it came to my faith."

What are some of your responsibilities as a Monsignor?

As Pastor of St. Andrew, Msgr. Moloney is responsible for saying Mass daily; responding to requests for sacraments such as Anointing of the Sick; hearing Confessions; preparing couples for weddings; celebrating weddings and funerals; consoling those who have lost loved ones; and the administration of St. Andrew Parish.

At the Diocese, he is responsible for the administration of the Diocese; dealing with problems that come up; helping priests when they need assistance; assignment of priests and transfer of priests.

What are some of your favorite prayers?

Msgr. Moloney shared three prayers he says every day. *The Morning Offering* as soon as he wakes up; *The Prayer Before the Crucifix* which he says after he receives Communion; *The Act of Contrition* which he says before he goes to sleep at night.

What advice do you have for making your faith a priority as you get older?

"Pray. That is really essential. I also have to say never miss Mass." Msgr. Moloney shared that he had always been able to say that he has never missed Mass on a Sunday or a Holy Day aside from two times that he remembers. Once when he was young in grade school, he was sick and missed Midnight Mass on Christmas. And once the summer before his senior year of high school, he went to Buckeye Boys State. It was a week-long trip and they stayed in the dorms at Ashland. There was no Catholic Mass on Sunday there, and he didn't have a way to get to Mass so he had to miss. He said, "Those were the only times in my life I missed Mass ... UNTIL JAN 2, 2022 when I tested positive for COVID. And now I can't say that I have only missed Mass twice in my life anymore."

What Saint do you look up to the most?

"St. John Vianney, who is the patron saint of parish priests and St. Joseph – that is my middle name – he was quiet and I like quiet people," he said with a chuckle.

How has your role and/or daily tasks changed now that you are acting Bishop of the Diocese of Columbus?

"I am not the Bishop. I am just subbing for the Bishop. As I have put it, it has certainly made my life more complicated. I have more events I am expected to be at. Before, I would work with the Bishop and we would arrive at a decision together, but now I have to make the decision and carry it out. It is different. I have more responsibility now but also more of the same."

A DAY IN THE LIFE OF MSGR. MOLONEY

Msgr. Moloney shared what a typical weekday is like. He wakes up early, around 5 a.m. (if he has the 8:30 a.m. Mass instead of the 6:30, he can sleep in a little bit). He prays his Daily Office reading and morning prayer; he gets dressed and ready to come over to the church for Mass. He celebrates Mass and goes back to the Rectory to have coffee and read the paper. He also spends some time outside with his dog, Mabel. He typically checks in with some of the parish office staff to see if they have anything they need from him. He then heads downtown around 9 or 9:30 a.m. Sometimes before heading downtown, he has some time to play the organ, which is a hobby of his. He shared that he likes to play classical music. When we had a Bishop, Msgr. Moloney would meet with him and other diocesan leaders once he arrived downtown. His work there is typically different every day. Msgr. Moloney spends time there working until anywhere from 2:30 to 5:00 p.m. As soon as he gets back to the Rectory, he takes Mabel out. He then has messages to respond to, and depending on the day of the week, he has various other responsibilities like Adoration, Parish Council Meetings, Finance Council Meetings, liturgy committees, appointments with people for weddings, etc. He is also sometimes in charge of cooking dinner at the Rectory. He ends his busy days with his nighttime prayers.

The families that attend the bereavement luncheons are so touched by the generosity of the parish. It is a tremendous source of comfort during a difficult time.


