MESSAGE FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

Dear Parishioners:

Monsignor Moloney's schedule has been very busy as he continues his work as Diocesan Administrator at the dioceses combined with his work at St. Andrew Parish. We decided to give him a break from his regular message writing this week and share information that we find meaningful during this season of repentance and renewal. This will be a three-part series about the THREE PILLARS OF LENT, which help us discover the purpose of Lent and transform ourselves through the Gospel of Christ.

THE FIRST PILLAR: ALMSGIVING

WHAT IS IT?

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, no. 2462, almsgiving is a frequent theme of the Gospels – the foundational call of Christians to charity. During Lent, we are asked to focus more intently on “almsgiving,” which means donating money or goods to the poor and performing other acts of charity. As one of the three pillars of Lenten practice, almsgiving is “a witness to fraternal charity” and “a work of justice pleasing to God.” Throughout this bulletin, you’ll find many opportunities to take part in almsgiving here at St. Andrew.

HOW CAN WE LIVE IT?

- » Dedicate time to your family, studies, work.
- » Help others through service or material goods.
- » Help others spiritually at home, your parish or other associations.
- » Be generous with our virtues: charity, forgiveness, patience, etc.

EXAMPLES:

- » Leave what I am doing to help in some domestic chore.
- » Offer a ride or assistance to a coworker, a fellow parishioner or a friend.
- » Donate clothing or other items to those in need.
- » Offer to volunteer at the parish.

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! Well, it happened again! Just like a year ago! The other day, I was minding my own business and peacefully napping, when suddenly Father Ferguson woke me up, grabbed me and shoved me into my cat carrier. I knew that meant only one thing! A trip to the doctor's office! And a cat doctor is called a "vet"!

At first, as you can imagine, I wasn't happy. I suddenly remembered last year's visit when I got poked and prodded all over, and had a sharp needle stuck into me. I was growling at Father all the way there from inside my carrier on the front seat!

But then, before he took me inside, Father explained to me that he wanted me to go to the cat doctor so that I could keep my body healthy. He said that we are made by God with two parts – a body and a soul! And just like we want to keep our soul healthy with things like prayer, Confession, and the acts of penance that we're doing during Lent to keep our souls strong and in shape, so too, we want to keep our body healthy. The body is a holy and special

part of who you are. And part of keeping your body healthy is to let a doctor check you over to make sure that nothing is going wrong with your body. And if something about your body is getting sick, it's easier to heal your body if you fix the illness sooner rather than later.

That made me feel better about going to the doctor. It can still sometimes be uncomfortable (those needles still hurt a little) but it's all part of keeping the body God gave you healthy and fit. The cat doctor checked me all over – my heart, my lungs, my fur, my eyes and ear, even my teeth! (Father was glad that I didn't decide to bite my doctor!) The doctor was really friendly, and by the time we left, I was glad to know that my body was still healthy! It gave me the desire to try all I can to live a healthy lifestyle! (The doctor recommended that I switch to eating low-fat mice, and to bake my birds, and not fry them...)

When's the last time you've been to the doctor for a check-up? Why not take a moment and pray to Jesus asking Him to bless all our doctors and nurses, and to help keep your body healthy? Have a "purr"-fect week!






