MESSAGE FROM THE PARISH OFFICE

Dear Parishioners,

We have arrived at the Third Week of Lent. How are you doing with your Lenten penances? Are you being faithful to the resolutions you made at the beginning of Lent? If you have weakened somewhat or maybe didn't really get a good start, now is a good time to regroup and restart. There are still four weeks of Lent left, and you can make good use of this time to renew yourself through prayer, fasting and almsgiving.

I especially want to recommend prayer in this time when the peace and security of the world is threatened by the Russian invasion of Ukraine. We have seen in the news and been disturbed by reports of innocent civilians being killed, their homes destroyed, missions of refugees fleeing for their lives, and in some cases being trapped and unable to flee. And we fear that an even greater conflict may ensue, and we dread the possibility of nuclear war. In this situation, we must pray for peace. We must petition the Prince of Peace, our Lord Jesus Christ, to restore peace on earth, the crush the madness of oppressors and to raise up the fallen. We must plead for the intercession of Our Lady, Queen of Peace, to obtain an end to war and the victory of peace. I invite you to join in praying the Rosary for Peace each Tuesday evening in church at 7:00 p.m. during Eucharistic Adoration.

Another opportunity to pray during Lent is "40 Days of Adoration" which is ongoing during this season. Each day in Lent, Eucharistic Adoration takes place in a different church of our diocese. On Tuesday, March 29, St. Andrew Parish will host Eucharistic Adoration from 9:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. that day. I hope you will join in prayer and Adoration on these days.

I wish to thank you for your generous response to the second collection last weekend to support Catholic Relief Services in Ukraine. Your generosity is greatly appreciated.

I am happy to inform you that a new bell controller has been installed to operate the tower bells at St. Andrew Church. So, we will once again hear the peal of bells ringing before Masses to draw us to Church for the Holy Sacrifice and to offer our praises to the Most High!

May God guide our feet in the way of peace!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! A few days ago, Father Ferguson came into the house here with his eyes big as saucers! I meowed to him what the matter was. He said, "I just came close to losing my life! I almost didn't make it!" Well, that sounded pretty dire. So, I asked Father how this happened. He sat down and took a deep breath and told me. He said he had just finished the altar server training for the 4th, 5th, and 6th graders of our parish, and it came time to show the kids where the ice cream was set up for them as a treat. Well, apparently, when the kids entered the room and saw the ice cream (two big tubs!), there was suddenly a mad stampede as 19 hungry kids ran at top speed to the serving table and surrounded it with cries of victory. After three minutes of batting the bells, Father had to take them away from me. He told me afterward that maybe we should leave serving to our parish children. Well, I suppose he's right. 

We are continuing our series from the March 13 bulletin sharing the purpose of Lent. Lent should be a time of spiritual renewal and purification that ultimately leads us to Christ. During this time, we purposefully fast, give alms, and pray with a heart that desires to know Jesus and serve Him, our actions move beyond requirements and rules. The three Pillars of Lent help us understand this purpose.

THE SECOND PILLAR: FASTING

WHAT IS IT?

Fasting is a restriction of consumption, deprivation of good and privation of evil for the glory of God. Simply stated, it's eating in moderation on the day practiced – one regular meal and two small meals without snacking in between. During Lent, we fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.

HOW CAN WE LIVE IT?

- » Eat and drink moderately.
- » Reduce expenses on trips, clothing and material items.
- » Abstain from the internet, TV and other media/entertainment.
- » Avoid sin, especially those of the flesh.

EXAMPLES:

- » Give up a food that you like during Lent.
- » Walk or ride a bike instead of driving.
- » Give up or limit time on social media during Lent.
- » Avoid cursing and gossiping.

1 COR 7:1-2

DIVINELY CARED FOR

Reflection on Luke 13:1-9

Oppression, suffering, fatal accidents, all make an appearance in this Gospel story. While these human experiences seem so random and are frightening to us, we have the assurance of Jesus that God does not use them as punishment for sin, nor are our lives devoid of God's enduring providence. Rather, through His own suffering and death, Jesus has made it eternally clear that He is never closer to us than in these times of trial.

We are that fig tree that is being cultivated, fertilized, divinely cared for so that we will bear fruit. By shifting the conversation from the disciples wondering if these victims brought these tragedies upon themselves by their sin and disobedience, to considering what a short time they themselves have for repenting and bearing fruit, Jesus cuts to the heart of the truth that the Kingdom, God's rule, is here and now.

When Jesus spoke of God's providence, He did not do so in tragic terms—lightning bolts and punishments—but rather he spoke of God artistically, clothing lilies, or functionally feeding sparrows, or lazily counting every hair on each human head! That is real, personal, loving involvement with the world, with us.




