## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This Sunday is Laetare Sunday, the Fourth Sunday of Lent. "Laetare" means "Rejoice!" We rejoice because we have reached the halfway point of the penitential season of Lent. We are at the mid-point of our journey from Ash Wednesday to Easter. However, because of the world situation, the war in Ukraine, and the threat to peace in the world, we are too worried and preoccupied and we don't really feel much like rejoicing.

Last Friday, I celebrated a special Mass at the Cathedral to join in solidarity with Pope Francis as he consecrated all of humanity and especially Russia and Ukraine to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The Holy Father asked all bishops around the world to join with him in this consecration at the same hour that he was fulfilling this in Rome, and he asked that the priests and faithful join in this act of prayer and consecration for the cause of peace and an end to war. Having completed this act of consecration, we still must pray fervently for the conversion of hearts and that the peaceful reign of Christ may extend to every corner of the earth.

In the year 1960, our country faced a great crisis that threatened atomic warfare – the Cuban Missile Crisis. At that time, Bishop Issenmann composed a prayer and asked all faithful of the Diocese of Columbus to pray this prayer frequently. In the present crisis, I adapted this prayer slightly and have shared it with all the priests of our diocese with the suggestion that this prayer is used effectively to plead with a bid for peace in our time and deliver the world from this present crisis.

I share this prayer with you today. It is found just after this message. I invite you to join me in praying this prayer daily.

May God bless you all and strengthen you to complete the second half of your Lenten journey.

It was March 25, which we celebrate every year as the "Solemnity of the Annunciation." 



