We accomplish this through the celebration of the sacraments, proclaiming and living the Gospel, reaching out to others in justice and charity, and providing all parishioners abundant spiritual, educational, and social opportunities in order to be known as a faith-filled, engaged, and generous parish.

MESSAGE FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Happy Lent! Today we celebrate the First Sunday of Lent. I hope your Lent is off to a good start, and that you have begun this season of repentance and renewal with a firm purpose to forsake your sinful ways and be transformed by the Gospel of Christ. I urge you to take advantage of the many opportunities for spiritual growth and personal conversion available in our parish. If possible, consider participating in daily Mass during this season. The liturgy takes us on a pilgrimage of repentance and of following the Lord Jesus in discipleship, through the Paschal Mystery of His suffering, death and resurrection. This is the most powerful and effective way of experiencing the Lenten journey. Also, make time in Lent to receive the Sacrament of Reconciliation, especially if it has been a long time since your last Confession. And come to pray the Stations of the Cross here in church on the Friday evenings of Lent. These practices will enrich your experience of Lent, deepen your relationship with Christ, and lead to a joyous and grace-filled Easter for you.

This Sunday is also the Rite of Election, at which our catechumens who are preparing to be baptized into the Catholic Church at Easter will be formally chosen and enrolled among the "Elect." This is a diocesan celebration, and it will take place at St. Paul Church in Westerville on Sunday afternoon. Normally, it is presided over by the diocesan bishop; however, I will be the presider this year in my role as Diocesan Administrator. I congratulate all the Elect, and I look forward to the Easter Vigil when each of our catechumens and candidates will receive the Sacrament of Initiation.

I am very happy to inform you that I have removed the signs at the entrances of the church urging "Please wear a mask." Based on drastically lower transmission rates of COVID-19 and guidance from the CDC and local health authorities, it is no longer deemed necessary to wear a mask indoors. I am sure that many of you may choose to continue to use a mask and I fully affirm, respect and support that decision. I am continuing the practice of having the priests, deacons and lay ministers wear masks while distributing communion, at least for the time being. Also, I want to assure those who are more vulnerable to infection or are at higher risk because they are immunocompromised or due to other factors, may be legitimately excused from the obligation of attending Sunday Mass.

May God bless you in this season of Lent and lead you to greater knowledge and love of Him and one another.

SYNODAL PROCESS MEETINGS



Question 1:

The Synodal process invites each one of us - the People of God to recall that we journey together. Moreover, in that journey of faith, we are called to listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit.

- As you listen to the voice of the Holy Spirit, what have been the joys and obstacles in your journeying together with the church?
- Please share a brief story that illustrates your experience.

Question 2:

"Listening is the first step, but it requires an open mind and heart, without prejudice." (Preparatory Document no. 30) and "All are invited to speak with courage and parrhesia, that is, in freedom, truth, and charity." (Preparatory Document no. 30).

- How have you experienced the Church reaching out to those who are on the peripheries and marginalized, including cultural groups, women, the disabled, those who experience poverty, marginalization, or social exclusion?
- What enables or hinders you from speaking up courageously, candidly, and responsibly in your parish and society?

Question 3:

"Synodality is at the service of the mission of the Church, in which all members are called to participate. A Synodal church is a participatory and co-responsible Church." (Preparatory Document no. 30).

- How do we promote participation in decision-making within hierarchically structured communities?
- What hinders people from being active in your parish?
- How is authority or governance exercised in your local parish?

CHILLER UPDATE! The much anticipated new chiller is on the way and installation is planned the week of March 13.

In the next few weeks, you'll see safety fencing go up and a small crane will be placed in the Reed Road parking lot turnaround. The crane will be used to remove the grating from the chiller pit. During this time, the front doors to the church may not be accessible.

Once the grating is removed, the crane will be set up on Reed Road to remove the old chiller and set the new one into place. During this process, Reed Road will be closed from the McCoy Road intersection to Churchview.

The crane will move back to the parking lot turnaround to replace the steel grating, which means the front entrance of the church may not be accessible again.

Once installed, the final connections and start up will be completed and AC will flow through the church once again.




