St. Andrew Church is a community of Catholics committed to serving God by living our faith. We exist to fulfill the mission of the Roman Catholic Church at the local level by continuing the saving work of Christ. We accomplish this through the celebration of the sacraments, proclaiming and living the Gospel, reaching out to others in justice and charity, and providing all parishioners abundant spiritual, educational, and social opportunities in order to be known as a faith-filled, engaged, and generous parish.

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today is Palm Sunday, the beginning of Holy Week. We are able to celebrate the rituals of Holy Week in a more normal way this year, that is, not modified because of COVID restrictions. Although we are not yet ready to have Holy Communion under both forms (bread and wine) for the faithful, we will again have altar servers assisting the priests at the altar beginning in Holy Week, and we will have the congregation participate in the proclamation of the Lord's Passion on Palm Sunday and Good Friday. Last year, we had no missals in the pews, and a different manner of proclaiming the Passion was used. I believe it is important and significant that on Palm Sunday, we use our voices both to sing Hosannas to the Lord and to cry out "Crucify him!" with the angry crowds. We must acknowledge our responsibility for the death of the Lord, the fickleness of our hearts, and our disloyalty to the one who shed His blood for the forgiveness of our sins.

Please remember that forgiveness of your sins is available throughout Holy Week, including on Monday (Reconciliation Monday), when Confessions will be heard from 4:00 to 7:00 p.m. On Wednesday, Confessions will be heard from 7:00 p.m. until all are heard, and on Good Friday, following the afternoon Liturgy of the Passion of the Lord, Confession will be available until all are heard.

Although this is a solemn week, we are also rejoicing greatly following the announcement last Saturday of the appointment of Rev. Earl Fernandes as the 13th Bishop of Columbus. Bishop-elect Fernandes will be consecrated and installed on Tuesday, May 31. Details of this will be forthcoming. Fr. Fernandes is a wonderfully gifted priest, and will be a faithful and reliable shepherd for Christ's flock in the Diocese of Columbus. I am especially thrilled – and relieved – by this announcement, and I pledge my support to our new Bishop!

I wish all of you a most blessed Holy Week!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. Did you know that today starts the most important week of the whole year? That's right! It's "Holy Week"! It's the week when Jesus comes into the city of Jerusalem and gets ready to die on the Cross and rise from the dead. And Jesus did that in order to take away our sins and to open Heaven up for us. Holy Week is a week when we get to see just how much Jesus – God – loves us. Jesus was even willing to suffer and die so that we could be happy in Heaven forever someday. What a great kind of love that is!

As a cat, if I were there with Jesus during Holy Week, I'd show Jesus how much I supported Him in all the love and sacrifice He was showing to all of us. For example, on Palm Sunday, I would join the crowds in loudly meowing my praises of Jesus. At the Last Supper on Holy Thursday, I'd share my tuna with Jesus as He shared the first Eucharist with His Apostles. On Good Friday, I'd bite the soldiers trying to hurt Jesus, and I'd jump into Mary's lap and try to comfort her as she watched her Son Jesus die on the Cross. And then, on Easter morning, I'd race and beat Mary Magdalene back to town to meow to all the Apostles about Jesus' Resurrection!

What would be some of the things YOU would do if you were there with Jesus all during Holy Week? Well, the best thing we CAN do this week to show our support for Jesus' sacrifice and love for us is to come to church all during Holy Week on all these special days to be with Jesus during all these important moments in His life. It means so much to Jesus when we show Him love, as the one who gave His whole life for us. So, tell your parents to do two things today: 1) feed your cat, and 2) bring you to church all during this Holy Week to spend time with Jesus! Have a "purr"-fect week!

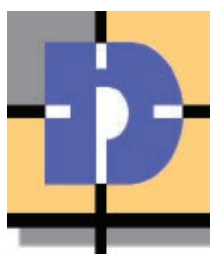

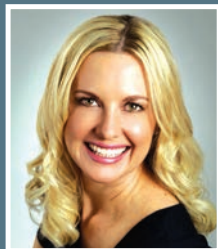
