## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Today is the Octave of Easter, and so I take the occasion to wish all of you a Happy Easter once again! The Church celebrates the Easter feast for eight straight days (an "octave") as if it were one giant feast day. This Sunday is the eighth and final day of the Easter Octave. The Easter season will continue through the feast of Pentecost which, this year, is on June 5.

This coming Saturday, April 30, we will be celebrating First Holy Communion at St. Andrew Parish. Our second grade children in St. Andrew School and the Parish School of Religion have been preparing for their First Communion all year and will receive the Body of Christ for the first time on Saturday at a special Mass at 11:00 a.m. It is a proud and exciting moment for them and their families, and I pray that these children will be regular and frequent Communicants their entire lives and will always strive to be holy.

The month of May begins next Sunday – May is a busy month, with end-of-school year activities, First Communion and Mother's Day. Most importantly, we will gather for the Ordination and Installation of our new Bishop, Earl Fernandes, which will take place on Tuesday, May 31. We are all looking forward to that happy day.

Before that, however, we also must get ready for the 2022 Bishop's Annual Appeal! The BAA is extremely important for the Diocese of Columbus to carry on its work and to support the various ministries of the church. Next weekend, April 30 and May 1, is the kick-off weekend for this year's BAA and you will hear more about the need and be asked to participate. The goal for St. Andrew Parish this year is \$205,155. That is our share of the overall diocesan goal of \$6.85 million. I hope all of you will be ready and willing to support this year's BAA beginning next weekend.

## THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi, boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. You know what? Today is still Easter! That's right. Easter is so special that it lasts not just one day (last Sunday), but EIGHT DAYS, all the way through today, the Second Sunday of Easter. We call this past week the "Easter Octave" (the word "octave" is based on the Latin word for "eight"). And today, the eighth and last day of the Octave, has another special name, too: "Divine Mercy Sunday."



A few years ago, St. Pope John Paul II declared that today would be "Divine Mercy Sunday" to celebrate the special miracle that happened not too long ago in history. In the 1930s, our Lord Jesus appeared in a special way to a nun named St. Faustina Kowalska in a faraway land called Poland. And Jesus told St. Faustina that He wanted her to tell the world how much Jesus wants the world to know of His "mercy." Mercy is another word for forgiveness and love. God does not want to hold our sins against us, so God shows "mercy" upon us, so that we can live in His friendship and love. It's kind of like when I used to scratch the furniture when I was a kitten. Father Ferguson tried not to get too angry with me, but he would show mercy to me and help me to learn, grow, and improve. Now, I'm a better cat; I don't scratch the furniture, but I take peaceful naps on it instead.

Jesus wants us to become better and better humans and to get ready for heaven...that's called "holiness." And His mercy and patience help you to do that. Why not take a few moments today and ask your parents to look up the "Divine Mercy Chaplet" on the computer, and help you learn to pray this great prayer that Jesus told St. Faustina to teach the world? It's a great way to celebrate "Divine Mercy" and the Easter joys of God's love for you. Have a "purr"-fect week!

**PS.** Kids, I want to make a correction to my last week's message about Easter. When I said to "eat lots of Easter bunnies," I meant "candy Easter bunnies," not the real thing. I suppose it wouldn't be nice to eat an actual Easter bunny!



**ARISE: A VIRTUAL MOTHER'S DAY RETREAT FOR THOSE IN A SEASON OF INFERTILITY**

Mother's Day can be the hardest day of the year for those who carry the cross of infertility and pregnancy loss. But you don't have to face it alone. 
