Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we begin the Bishop's Annual Appeal for 2022. We are preparing as a diocese for the ordination and installation of Most Reverend Earl Fernandes as the 13th Bishop of Columbus, which will take place on May 31. In the weeks before then, we are inviting parishioners to support the Bishop's Annual Appeal, which is a major source of support for the ministries and services provided by the Diocese of Columbus. We look forward to our new bishop leading our diocesan church from strength to strength, and it is my hope that he will begin his ministry here on a firm foundation, which we will help to provide through our generous support of the Bishop's Annual Appeal!

I have always counted on the generous response of St. Andrew parishioners in many ways and for many causes. I also am aware that the Diocese of Columbus and our bishops have relied on the support given by St. Andrew parishioners to the Bishop's Annual Appeal. So, I am asking you to do so again for this year's appeal – and I ask not only as your pastor, but also in my role as Diocesan Administrator.

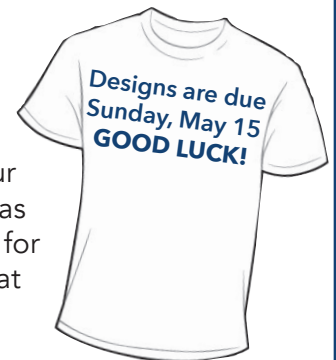

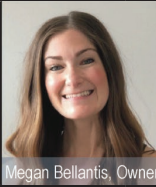

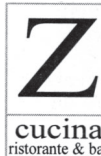
