## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

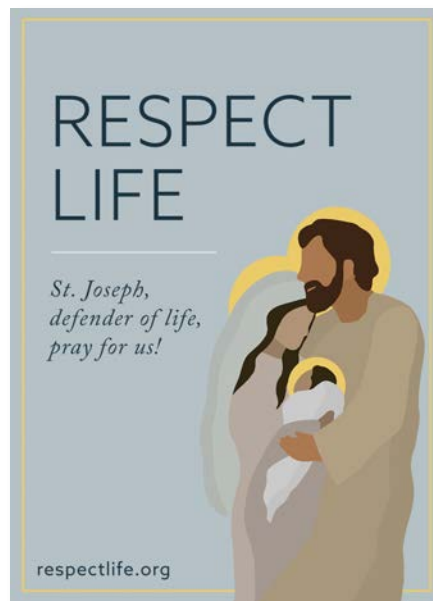
Last week, we learned about the leak of a draft decision from the U.S. Supreme Court which seemed to indicate that the Court was preparing to overturn the infamous 1973 decision "Roe vs. Wade." After the initial shock of learning the confidentiality of the Supreme Court had been violated, I nevertheless hoped that this was true, because this is what all pro-life Catholics have been hoping and praying for during the last almost 50 years.

I was 17 years old in 1973 when I heard about the Supreme Court's decision in the Roe v. Wade case on the evening news. I was shocked and dismayed at that time, and wondered how such a decision could be made in the name of justice, and how a "right" to destroy the life of an unborn child could be asserted as a fundamental constitutional right. How could such a "wrong" be a right? I believed that Roe v. Wade was bad law in 1973, and so I am full of hope that this bad law will now be finally overturned, and that the right to life for all people will be legally protected from conception to natural death.

Of course, not all are happy about this development. Last week, Catholic churches around the country were placed on alert for possible disruptions and protests by pro-abortion groups who were apparently calling for protests at Catholic churches during Masses on Mother's Day. We prepared for this possibility here at St. Andrew also. I am happy to say that we did not experience any interruptions, nor am I aware of any anywhere in the Diocese of Columbus. If any such interruption should ever occur in the future, I would simply ask that everyone remain calm, and allow police or parish staff to remove the protesters. Those attending Mass should not engage with the protesters at all.

This only reminds us that, although we see a victory for the cause of Life on the horizon, there will still be much work to do in the defense of human life for a long time to come.

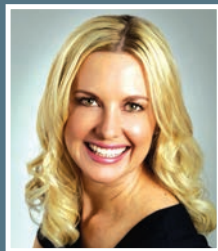

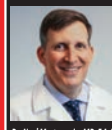
