13th Bishop of Columbus



THE MOST REVEREND EARL K. FERNANDES



Appointed by Pope Francis on April 2, 2022, as the 13th Bishop of the Diocese of Columbus, Reverend Earl K. Fernandes succeeds The Most Reverend Robert J. Brennan, who was installed as the 8th Bishop of Brooklyn on November 21, 2021. Fr. Fernandes, 49, was ordained a priest of the Archdiocese of Cincinnati, Ohio by the Most Reverend Daniel Pilarczyk on May 18, 2002. He most recently served as the pastor of St. Ignatius of Loyola Church in Cincinnati.

"I look forward to meeting the People of God – the priests, deacons, religious, and lay faithful of the Diocese of Columbus – and to collaborating with them in announcing the joyful Good News and building the Kingdom of God. I ask for your prayers, not only for me but also for our Diocese, that the Holy Spirit may enkindle in all of us the fire of His Divine Love. May God grant me the grace to serve His people well and to be an ardent yet gentle shepherd, whose heart is formed after the Heart of Jesus."

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we celebrate the Solemnity of the Ascension of the Lord. Many of us remember that this feast was formerly known as "Ascension Thursday" and was celebrated on the Thursday of the Sixth Week of Easter. In fact, in some places, it is still observed then. However, in most regions of the United States, the feast has been transferred to the Sunday following. While this is more convenient for all of us, we no longer celebrate the Seventh Sunday of Easter, nor do we hear the readings for that Sunday, which prepare us for the feast of Pentecost.

This weekend is also Memorial Day weekend, the unofficial start of Summer. While enjoying this holiday, please remember to pray for all the dead, including those who died in service to our country and your own departed family members, friends and loved ones. Let us also pray for those who died by violence, like the victims of the school shooting in Texas and the victims of the war in Ukraine. And let us not forget all of those who died from COVID-19 disease in the pandemic.

Tuesday of this week is the day of the ordination and installation of our new Bishop of the Diocese of Columbus, Earl Fernandes. Soon we will be able to pray at Mass "in communion with Francis our Pope and Earl our Bishop." I am very happy and pleased to welcome Bishop Fernandes to the Diocese of Columbus.

This is also an eventful week here at St. Andrew as Thursday, June 2, is the last day of school! I wish all of our students a happy summer vacation! The evening before, Wednesday, June 1, is Graduation for the St. Andrew School Class of 2022. I heartily congratulate our graduates, and wish them a bright future.

I want to share with you some new additions to our parish staff. Ms. Tina White will be our new Director of Religious Education beginning July 1. Tina has been our second-grade teacher this past year at St. Andrew School, and has great experience in leading religious education programs in several diocesan parishes. Suzie Emsweller, our long-time D.R.E, is retiring. I have known Suzie since I was first ordained, and I will miss her. But I am also enthusiastic to welcome Tina to this role. Also, Emily Jaminet will be our new Director of R.C.I.A. and Adult Faith Formation. This is a newly created part-time position. Emily is a parishioner, an author, a mother, and an enthusiastic evangelizer. Welcome Tina and Emily to our staff, and Thank You to Suzie and best wishes for your retirement!

One last thing: Sunday, June 12, is the 40th anniversary of my ordination to the priesthood. I was ordained on June 12, 1982 by Bishop Edward J. Herrmann at St. Joseph Cathedral. I will be celebrating the 11:00 a.m. Mass on Sunday, June 12, as my Anniversary Mass. I have invited a few family members and priest friends to join me, but I mainly want to celebrate with you, the parishioners of St. Andrew. Therefore, I cordially invite you to join with me on June 12 at the 11:00 Mass as I give thanks for 40 years of priestly service, and also to join me for refreshments after the Mass in the Parish Hall. *May God bless you all, and may you have a wonderful week!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN


by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. Ooh! Ooh! I am really excited! This week will be my birthday! I am turning 14 years old. That's right! I was born on a farm near the city of Marion, not too far from here, back in the year 2008. And when I was only seven weeks old, I went to live with Father Ferguson.
