MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

It is now the month of May, the month dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary, and also the month when the danger of frost passes and we plant our gardens in anticipation of summer. This is the month in which traditionally we bring "flowers of the fairest and flowers of the rarest" to crown the "Queen of the May," our blessed Mother Mary. Flowers have long been associated with the Blessed Virgin Mary, and many of the flowers you will plant and cultivate in your garden are named for Mary, or have colloquial names as well as legends associated with them that refer to the Virgin Mary and events in her life.

The most common flower named for Mary is marigold. Gold is the color of royalty and Mary is our queen with a crown of gold upon her head. The fragrant rosemary also has the name of Mary in it. "Rosemary" literally means "rose of the sea" (rosa maris) because it thrives in rocky places with sea breezes. This reminds us that Mary is hailed the "star of the sea" (ave maris stella).

Roses are especially associated with Mary because of the Rosary, which is a word that refers to a garland of roses. Likewise, lilies symbolize purity, and represent the purity and virginity of Mary. You may have "August lilies" in your garden (a perennial species of hosta), which are also called "Assumption lilies" because they bloom in mid-August, and August 15 is the Feast of the Assumption of Mary. This time of year, you may find lilies of the valley blooming in your yard or in the wild. These are known as "Our Lady's tears." And flowers like "Lady's slipper" and "Lady's mantle" are actually "our Lady's."

The iris is a perennial whose flower is the fleur-de-lis, a symbol of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Irises are blooming right now around the statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary in the garden behind the rectory!

I hope you enjoy this month of May and even manage to plant some flowers in your garden. When you do, I hope you will say a prayer to the Virgin Mary.
