This is the mystery we profess every time we make the sign of the Cross "In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, Amen." While we don't usually celebrate this feast with the same splendor and festivity as we celebrate Christmas, Easter and Pentecost, this is nevertheless an important feast which we should observe with due solemnity and joy, so as to give Glory to God.

This weekend, I am also celebrating my 40th anniversary of my Ordination to the Priesthood. I give thanks to almighty God for the gift of the priesthood and for sustaining me in my ministry for 40 years, the last 9 of these years having been here at St. Andrew! I am very grateful to all of you for your support and prayers, and for your understanding and acceptance of my frequent absences as I fulfill my duties to my "other job" in the diocesan Chancery. I have been working in the Chancery for 34 of my 40 years of priesthood. Thank you for your prayers and good wishes. I will continue to do my best to serve the parishioners of St. Andrew in the days ahead.

Thanks to all who have provided feedback to the Second Round Draft Models developed by the *Real Presence, Real Future* strategic planning initiative of our diocese. There has been a good number of comments, suggestions and constructive ideas shared already, and also some concerns and apprehensions. It is important that parishioners' voices be heard in this process. You still have until June 30 to review the models and complete the survey, so please take advantage of this opportunity. 




