

MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

As most of you know, I was recently away from St. Andrew for my annual vacation. I was away from June 20 through July 2. I want to thank Deacon Berg and Deacon Dowler who "filled in" for me by writing this bulletin message while I was away. I enjoyed reading their thoughts and ideas, and I am sure you did, also. I am happy to say that my vacation was relaxing and refreshing. I spent those days at my home in Ada, Ohio. I took long walks, worked around my house, visited with my brother, sisters and niece, sat on my front porch and took naps with Mabel! And after two weeks, I was ready to come back to St. Andrew and get busy doing the work of priestly ministry among all of you.

One evening during my vacation, I was with my brother and sister, and we had gone to an ice cream stand on highway 81 several miles west of Ada. We were having turtle sundaes. As we sat at the picnic table enjoying our ice cream, I looked across the road and observed a huge harvesting machine mowing the ripe wheat. The sun was low in the western sky and shining golden rays on the wheat field; the green trees beyond the field were glowing also in the light of the sun. The air was clear, and the sky was blue, and the wheat in the field gleamed like platinum. I immediately recalled the words of Jesus; "Behold, the fields are shining for the harvest" (John 4:35). Seeing that wheat field literally "shining" and the farmer busy harvesting the crop as the sun was setting, reminded me of my own vocation.

As a priest, I have been called to be a laborer in the Lord's harvest. It does give me great joy and satisfaction to fulfill my calling as a priest, especially the pastoral care of St. Andrew Parish, including the celebration of the sacraments, preaching the Gospel, and all that is entailed in the care of souls. But I am also concerned about the future, especially given the rapidly declining number of priests. I belong to a category of priests who will reach retirement age within a few short years. I will turn 70 years of age in 2026 – only four years from now. While I plan to continue to work as long as I am able, I know there will be fewer priests available to take my place when the day comes. Let us pray, therefore, to the Lord of the Harvest, asking Him to send us laborers for the harvest!

While we are praying for vocations, let us also ask the Lord to strengthen and protect all of our active and retired priests, and grant them lasting good health that they may continue their valuable and faithful service to God's people – especially Fr. DeVille who contributes so much to the life of St. Andrew Parish and whom we depend on for his priestly and sacramental service.

May God bless you all during these summer days!

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. Did you know that all throughout the year, we Catholics honor various saints on specific days? That's right! For example, St. Francis of Assisi (who loved animals!) is celebrated every October 4. Well, this coming Thursday – which is July 14, we celebrate another special saint: Saint Kateri Tekakwitha! That's meowed, "Teh-kuh-WITH-a." That's a whiskerful!

St. Kateri Tekakwitha was a holy young woman; she was a Native American born back in the year 1656. She was born in a tiny Indian village on the Mohawk River near the current-day town of Auriesville in the state of New York. Her parents died when she was really young. As a young girl, Kateri had a desire to be holy. There were some local Catholic missionaries who tried to share our faith in Jesus with the Mohawk Indians. Many rejected the faith, but Kateri fell in love with Jesus and wanted to be baptized. In 1676, when she was 20, Kateri was finally baptized. But because of her faith in Jesus, Kateri was made fun of by a lot of her native people in her village. So, soon, she travelled many miles north to live along the St. Lawrence River (in Canada) with other Native American Catholics who supported her faith. Kateri was sick a lot, but she always stayed dedicated to Jesus. Finally, in 1680, only 24 years old, Jesus took her to Heaven! Kateri was made a saint by Pope Benedict XVI not long ago...in 2012!

St. Kateri shows how young people can make a big difference in following Jesus and being holy, even when it's not always popular. Plus, St. Kateri shows how the love of Jesus is available to ALL humans (and cats), no matter our culture, background, or race. Father Ferguson is from the state of New York, and he told me that he has visited the shrine of St. Kateri Tekakwitha along the Mohawk River (near Fonda, NY). It's at the same spot of the second Indian village where she lived as a girl, and you can even see markers in the ground showing where the houses of her village used to be!

So, this Thursday, July 14, take a few moments and pray to St. Kateri and ask her to help you to stay holy even when it gets tough and people may pick on you for following Jesus. She's in Heaven to cheer you on! Have a "purr"-fect week!






