MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I want to remind you about the upcoming missionary appeal to take place at Saint Andrew parish on July 30 and 31. This appeal is part of the missionary cooperation plan which all diocesan parishes participate in. This appeal gives ordinary Catholics the opportunity to participate in the missionary action of the church. I spoke with Fr. Lawrence Chellaian recently and he is very excited to be visiting St. Andrew parish to make this appeal. He will be preaching at all the Masses next weekend. I hope that you will give him a warm welcome and a generous response on behalf of his missionary organization.

Fr. Lawrence will share the story of the Holy Family Mission and the group of missionary priests who work in the rural villages of Southwest India. Since the mission was established in 1936, the community has seen a steady growth in the number of Catholics in the area. The community gathers for Mass and other celebrations in a small temporary building, which is deteriorating and collapsing. Donations from St. Andrew parishioners will help to build a small church building where the community can gather for sacramental and other celebrations. Thank you for your response to this missionary appeal.
