THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. Well, this weekend is a special one for our great Republic! That's right! This weekend, we get ready to celebrate July 4 as Independence Day! That's right!

Back in the year 1776, our Founding Fathers insisted that all people have human dignity from being created by God, and that a good nation – and its leaders – should respect that dignity. 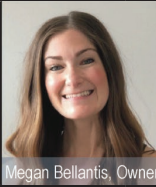
