## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Festival Week is here! The 20th Festival at St. Andrew is happening this coming Friday and Saturday, August 19 and 20. This will be an especially welcome event not only because of the milestone "twentieth," but also because we have missed our Festival in the last two years because of the pandemic. I am looking forward to a really good time, and to seeing all of you there, likewise having a really good time. Please remember that on Festival Saturday, August 20, the Vigil Mass will be celebrated at 4:00 p.m., rather than the usual 4:30 p.m.

There is another special occasion occurring this week. Monday, August 15, is the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Normally, this feast is a Holy Day of Obligation, but because it falls on a Monday this year, the obligation of attending Mass on the holy day is dispensed. Some years ago, the bishops of the United States established a rule that when certain holy days (namely, January 1, Mary Mother of God, August 15, Assumption, or November 1, All Saints) fall on Mondays or Saturdays, the obligation is dispensed. December 8, Immaculate Conception, and December 25, Christmas, are always days of obligation no matter what day of the week they occur. This dispensation is intended to ease the burden of having a holy day of obligation back-to-back with a Sunday, and two consecutive days with a full schedule of Masses. Although that is appreciated, it can be somewhat confusing when these feasts are days of obligation in some years but not in others. This year, the Solemnity of the Assumption will be observed on Monday, August 15, and Masses will be celebrated at 6:30 and 8:30 a.m. according to our regular weekday Mass schedule.

I wish you all a happy Festival Week!






