THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. Well, school is back in session! That's right! I hope your first days of school have gone well for you! I bet it's been fun to see some of your old friends and also to make new friends, too. And school is a great place to learn how to use the mind that God gave you to learn about God's world and how to grow up to do great things for other people.

Did you know that all the most famous people of the world once were little kids who went to school and had to learn new things from their teachers? George Washington grew up on a farm near the tiny town of Fredericksburg in the state of Virginia, in the 1730s. Do you know where Virginia is? George studied at the small local school in town, and enjoyed learning about math. Math helped George to get his first job as a surveyor, which is someone who measures land. But his education helped him to do other things, too. Do you remember what kinds of things George Washington did later in his life for our nation?

Another famous person who was once a kid in school was St. John Paul II. He was one of our recent Popes, and he grew up in the town of Wadowice in the far-away country called Poland in the 1920s. Can you find Poland on a map? St. John Paul (his name as a kid was actually "Karol," which is like "Charles" in English) went to school in Wadowice and made lots of friends, including many of the local Jewish kids. He would often play soccer with them. Karol liked to study not only religion, but also theatre and drama. At first, Karol was going to become an actor. But then God told him that He wanted Karol to become a priest, and to use all the things he was learning in order to lead others into holiness as followers of Jesus. That's what Karol did, all the way to becoming our Pope with a new name, "John Paul the Second"!

See how important a good education is? It can help you to be of service to others and to help God's plan to prepare everyone for Heaven. What do you hope to learn more about during this coming school year? As a cat, I want to learn more about hunting techniques, so I can hunt more food and help feed the poor! Have a "purr"-fect week!






