

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. I'm having a tough time as summer vacation keeps going. That's right! When vacation started two months ago, I was so excited about all the free time I was going to have. I had all kinds of plans to do lots of great things: go outdoors on squirrel hunting trips; read new books about cat explorers; and make new friends at Vacation Bible School. I've done those things, but I still had so much extra free time that I've also gotten into some bad habits, too.

One bad habit I've gotten into has been spending too much time on video games. That's right! At first, a few weeks ago, I was just going to play a few minutes of "Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles." But then a few minutes quickly became a couple of hours...then three...then four! And when I got tired of that game, I went onto "Grand Theft Salmon." 


