Dear St. Andrew Parishioners,

My name is Tyler Carter, and I'm a seminarian for the Diocese of Columbus who has been assigned to your parish for the next two years. I'll be with you most weekends throughout the school year as I finish my final years in seminary and prepare for ordination to the diaconate in May 2023 and the Priesthood in June 2024, God-willing.

I was born and raised in Columbus, and I'm the youngest of two children. I'm a St. Patrick parishioner and an alumnus of Mater Dei Academy and Bishop Watterson High School (Go Eagles!). After graduating from Watterson in 2015, I entered the College of Liberal Arts at the Pontifical College Josephinum and graduated in 2019 with a B.A. in Philosophy. I then did two years of Theology studies before going on pastoral year at St. Matthew in Gahanna last year.

During my time in seminary I've received candidacy, meaning I professed publicly that I'm resolved to prepare myself "in mind, heart and spirit" to minister to the faithful as a priest of Jesus Christ, and I have also been instituted into the ministries of Lector and Acolyte, meaning I have been specially entrusted by the Church with proclaiming the word of God, instructing people in the faith, distributing the Holy Eucharist, and instructing the faithful in carrying out their liturgical roles for Mass. Acolytes are also permitted to expose the Eucharist for veneration and to purify the sacred vessels which have held the Body and Blood of Christ. I am excited to exercise these ministries at St. Andrew and to prepare to minister to you as a deacon after ordination.

I look forward to getting to know many of you in the next weeks, and I'm excited to work and pray with you! God bless you, and let us pray for one another.


