MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

I want to welcome Fr. Doug Grandon to St. Andrew Parish this weekend. As I mentioned a few weeks ago, Fr. Grandon is here at my invitation to share with us information about FOCUS, the Fellowship of Catholic University Students, which is an organization dedicated to evangelizing students on university campuses through missionary outreach. He will also be telling us how we can support the mission of FOCUS. Please welcome Fr. Grandon to St. Andrew.

I hope that by this time, you have had an opportunity to check out the final recommendations from the "Real Presence, Real Future" strategic planning process for the Diocese of Columbus. The recommendations are now in the hands of Bishop Fernandes, who has indicated that he may take until Pentecost 2023 to consider these recommendations, but also that urgent needs may hasten the implementation of some of the models. Back when this process began, I indicated that all areas of the diocese would be affected by this planning process and that we should not expect that St. Andrew Parish would not see changes. In case you have not seen the final recommendations, let me at least fill you in on the model involving St. Andrew. The final recommendations have taken into account the feedback from priests and parishioners to the previous models. Thus, the time for commenting on the recommendations has now passed. The final recommendation that involves our parish has St. Andrew and St. Timothy parishes merging to become one parish with one pastor while maintaining two churches for the time being. St. Andrew School would remain a parochial school, while St. Timothy School would become a diocesan school. The time of the implementation of this model is not specified. While all of the models cannot possibly be implemented all at once, implementation could take place anytime beginning July 2023.




