MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

The month of September is quickly nearing its end – this weekend is the last before the calendar turns to October. Where does the time go? As the old saying has it, "tempus fugit," or "time flies."

Please pray for our parishioner and St. Andrew School student Audrey Wenzke who was recently diagnosed with lymphoma. Audrey is in the 8th grade, and her friends and classmates are gathering to pray for her in the church on Monday, Sept. 26, at 6:30 p.m. I will join them in prayer and I invite all of you to do so as well. Prayer is a powerful remedy!

Like millions around the world, I watched the funeral of Queen Elizabeth II this past Monday. As a priest who with some frequency preaches a homily at funerals, I was curious to hear what the preacher would say at the funeral of the Queen. I know I struggle to say just the right thing when I give a funeral homily, and I had sympathy for whoever had the duty of preaching for the Queen, to an audience of millions including numerous world leaders. The Archbishop of Canterbury, Justin Welby, was the preacher. The homily was excellent. It was eloquent. It was brief. It was not impersonal, but it focused primarily on the mystery of Christ. The emphasis was that the Queen's life of service and duty was the fulfillment of her Christian vocation. I feel he said just the right thing. I also noted that the funeral did not include a eulogy, and that the rites and prayers, readings and psalms were much the same as are heard in the funerals celebrated in our church. Finally, I heard the celebrant at one point refer to "our sister Elizabeth," recalling that the baptized are all brothers and sisters in the Body of Christ. In many respects, the Queen's funeral followed the pattern of the funeral rites as we celebrate them for our departed brothers and sisters, which made me proud of our Catholic funeral liturgy.

Please note that next Sunday, Oct. 2, I will conduct the annual Pet Blessing at 3:00 p.m. on the rectory lawn. This is in anticipation of the feast of St. Francis of Assisi (which falls on Tuesday, Oct. 4). Please bring your pets for this blessing. Mabel will be there to welcome all the animals and their people, and to receive the blessing also. She is now an elderly dog (she will be 14 years old in January).

May God's blessing be upon you all.



THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. It's been a tough week. As many of you know, one of the big kids in our parish in 8th grade, Audrey Wenzke, found out that she has a really bad illness called cancer. She's in the hospital, which is a special place where doctors and nurses help people to get better. But Audrey's illness is a tough one that will take a long time to get better from.

I've had a lot of different emotions over the last few days as I heard the news. We cats can have a wide range of emotions. On the same day, a cat can hiss at one thing and then purr about something else. All these feelings can be confusing. So, when I learned about Audrey's illness, I knew what I had to do. I knew I had to talk to Jesus in prayer. I shared with Jesus all my feelings. I told Jesus that I felt really sad that Audrey is now so sick. I even told Jesus that I was really mad that the big bad illness called cancer would pick on a wonderful girl like Audrey. But I also told Jesus that I felt really glad and happy that Audrey was already getting a lot of love and care and support from so many people: her family, her doctors and nurses, her friends and teachers at school, and from the whole community!

And you know what? In my prayer, I sensed Jesus telling me that He was supporting Audrey as well. Jesus reminded me that He came into this world to fight everything that's bad and evil. And Jesus also reminded me that He went through a lot of suffering and crosses, too. So, He told me that He would be there with Audrey in her illness, and that no matter what, nothing – not even sickness – would take Audrey away from His great love for her. Jesus was uniting her to His Sacred Heart of love!

I was glad I talked to Jesus in prayer. I still have a lot of questions and worries, but Jesus said that that's OK. He would be there to give all of us peace. Like us cats, you humans have a lot of emotions, too. So, boys and girls, as you pray to Jesus for Audrey in her illness, know that it's OK to share all your emotions with Jesus. And talk to your parents about what you're feeling, too. I did that with Father Ferguson. They want to help you find peace, too. So this week, let's all together meow a ton of prayers for Audrey, so that she, too, can feel a lot of peace from being embraced by the love of Jesus and everyone in our community!






