MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend is a holiday weekend, and Labor Day is Monday, Sept. 5. This holiday marks the end of Summer for practical purposes, just as Memorial Day marked the beginning. That is true in parish life, also. Activities and meetings that took a break over the Summer are gearing up to resume again. I had meetings this past week to prepare for the parish Finance Council meetings for the coming year, and a similar one to prepare for our Liturgy Committee. Last week, I also met with our RCIA team (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults) to plan the schedule of that program for the coming year. This coming week, I will meet with leaders of the Parish Council to prepare for the first meeting of that group for this fiscal year. I am happy to see this renewed activity as it is a sign of the vitality and vibrancy of our parish of St. Andrew.

I am hopeful that the Fall will also see our Sunday Mass attendance surge once again and that all parishioners who are able will once again be coming to Mass "in person." Last year, our "October count" (the annual average Sunday Mass attendance calculation based on the actual count of attendance during the month of October) was below 900. I don't think it has really increased much since then. I am hoping that more and more will make Sunday Mass a priority for themselves and their families, and St. Andrew Church will be filled every Sunday. I hope that at least we will return to pre-pandemic levels of attendance this year, and that our October Count will be more like 1,400. We will see!

Just a reminder that on Monday (Labor Day) there will be only one Mass at 9:00 a.m. Please join us as we pray for God's blessing upon our labor, and ask that He may "give success to the work of our hands."
