MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

October has arrived and with it, the fall season with its cooler temperatures and shorter days. October is also Respect Life Month, a time designated by the church to raise awareness about the sacredness of all human life from conception to natural death. It is a time to pray, witness and advocate for the protection of all human life. While the Supreme Court's decision to overturn *Roe v. Wade* was a victory for the pro-life cause, there is still work to be done. As Catholics, we are pro-life. This is established in the doctrine of the church as expressed in the Catechism of the Catholic Church as well as the law of the church, the constant moral teaching and papal pronouncements, ancient and modern.

Although the issue of abortion gets the most attention in the cultural debate, the Catholic Church wants to draw attention to a wide range of life issues, and promote and advocate the greatest respect for all human life, "from conception to natural death." In addition to vigorously opposing abortion, we must also call attention to many other "life issues," including euthanasia, the death penalty, the drug overdoses epidemic, gun violence, poverty, famine, war, racism, ethnic cleansing, suicide...the list goes on and on.

During this month of October, this "respect life month," let us increase our efforts to protect and preserve all life, "from conception to natural death" using all the means available to us.

I want to let you know that I will be away on retreat the week of October 17-21. Priests are obliged to make an annual retreat consisting of spiritual exercises. Because of the demands of my many roles as pastor and diocesan official, it has been difficult for me to get away for a true retreat, and in fact, I have not had a retreat for several years. Now, I really feel the need for this time of solitude and prayer. I hope I am renewed and refreshed when I return.

May God bless you all in these autumn days!

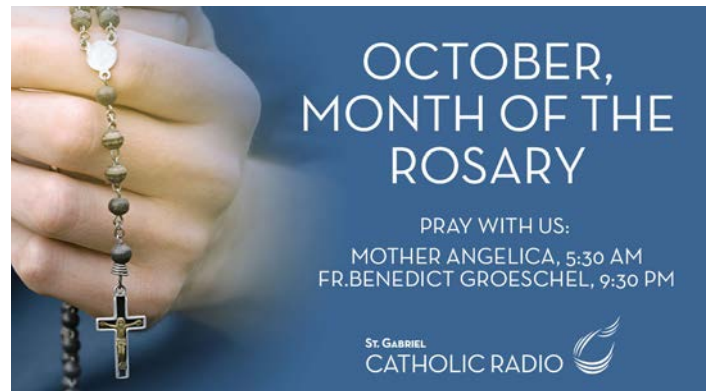
