## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This past week we have witnessed the devastation caused by Hurricane Ian, especially in Florida and extending to the Atlantic coastal states of Georgia, the Carolinas and Virginia. Cuba also was affected. Before that, Hurricane Fiona caused great damage in the Caribbean, especially Puerto Rico. Meanwhile, we were experiencing beautiful cool fall weather here. This reminds us how powerful and how fickle nature is.

I have received numerous inquiries asking if St. Andrew Parish would be responding to the great need for assistance in the areas devastated by these destructive storms. I am sure that all of us know people – family, friends, associates – who have been directly affected by the storms and the accompanying destruction and even loss of life. To help the victims of Hurricane Ian and other recent natural disasters, Bishop Fernandes has requested a special collection be taken to support Catholic Charities USA, which is already busy supplying relief aid in the devastated region. At St. Andrew Parish, I have designated the weekend of October 15-16 for this special collection, which will be taken up at all the weekend Masses. I know already that you will be generous, because I know that you are eager to help those who have suffered such great losses.

I have called upon your generosity many times and you, the parishioners of St. Andrew, have never failed me. So please be prepared to contribute to this important collection next weekend.




