## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

In last week's bulletin, I began discussion about the changing attitudes regarding infant Baptism and I announced that I would also offer further commentaries in the coming weeks about changing attitudes toward other celebrations such as weddings and funerals.

Today, I want to finish my commentary on Baptism. Last week, I wrote about the tendency of families to delay the Baptism of their children for months to a date when all the extended family members can be present, even though church law calls for infants to be baptized as soon as possible after their birth. Another trend that I've encountered is about the names given to children. In the past, it was considered necessary to give a child a saint's name at Baptism. The current law of the church does not strictly require this, it only insists that the name given to a child at Baptism must not be "foreign to the Christian mentality." As I have performed Baptisms over four decades, I have observed that many children are not given saints' names. In the rite of Baptism, there is a short litany of the saints prescribed, and there is a rubric that invites the celebrant to include the patron saints of those about to be baptized. I almost always omit this litany because one or more of the children presented for Baptism does not have a name that belongs to a saint. I am not suggesting that parents are doing something wrong in not choosing saints' names for their children; I only want to point out that attitudes have changed so we have to adjust to that reality.

As we reach mid-November, it is hard to believe that Thanksgiving is right around the corner! Also around the corner is "Giving Tuesday" on November 29. This year, we hope to raise money for much needed improvements at the Bryce Eck Center. More details are included to the right of this message about our Giving Tuesday project and how you can help.

May God bless all of you this week, and may the souls of all the faithful departed, through the mercy of God, rest in peace.

## GIVING TUESDAY

As we put the Pandemic behind us, we are happy to see parishioners return to the many group activities, meetings, and celebrations found here at the parish. Many of these activities take place in our parish hall, which is consistently booked by organizations from the church, school, and the Columbus Diocese. To accommodate the increased demand for space and meet the needs of the parish, we plan to take advantage of the spaces available at the Bryce Eck Center. For example, the ballroom at the Bryce Eck Center can accommodate events for anywhere from 20 to 150 people, offers integrated A/V equipment, and is easily accessible. Unfortunately, some of the equipment and fixtures are in disrepair and need to be replaced. The commercial refrigerator and ice machine no longer function, and the upholstery on most of the ballroom chairs is torn and continues to deteriorate with each use. Repairing these items is no longer cost-effective.

**Giving Tuesday is November 29**, and we are asking you to consider a donation toward the purchase of new chairs and kitchen equipment. We are hoping to raise \$15,000 to cover the cost of these items. The parish will match all donations up to \$7,500. Any donations over \$15,000 will be used to replace the aging freezer and to install storage cabinets in the balcony area.
