I wish you all a Happy Thanksgiving and God's blessing upon you and all your loved ones.



REAP THE MOST TAX BENEFIT WHILE SUPPORTING ST. ANDREW

ST. ANDREW: Maximize your giving dollars before the ball drops on New Year's Eve by using funds in your retirement account to support St. Andrew Church. The IRA Charitable Rollover allows donors who are 70.5 years or older to transfer up to \$100,000 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation. In doing so, donors keep their IRA distribution from impacting their gross income and possibly avoid being bumped into a higher tax bracket. The IRA charitable rollover can also count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD), which starts at age 72.

All transfers must be made directly from an IRA custodian to The Catholic Foundation by December 15th to qualify as a 2022 rollover and be excluded from the donor's taxable income. 

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat



Hi, boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat. Did you know that this Thursday is a special day called Thanksgiving? That's right! It's a chance for our nation to stop and to thank God for all the blessings which He has given to our great country.

Our American custom of giving thanks at this time of year has a lot of historical roots, including when some of the first English settlers to America – the Pilgrims – held a "harvest feast" in the autumn of 1621. The Pilgrims had landed in what's now Massachusetts in November of 1620 and had a rough first winter. Half of the 100 Pilgrims from the Mayflower died during that first winter due to disease and the cold. But in the summer of 1621, with the help of the local Native Americans, they had a good crop and harvest, and they wanted to celebrate and give thanks to God.

One of those Pilgrims, a man named James Chilton, is actually an ancestor of Father Ferguson! Sadly, both James and his wife were among those who died soon after the Mayflower landed. But before he died, James was able to be one of the signers of the "Mayflower Compact." That was a document which established some of our first American laws on how to treat each other fairly, a preparation for our Constitution.

What are the things for which you are thankful? Our great nation? Your family? Friends? Home? As a cat, I am thankful for Father Ferguson's care and love, for all of you as our parish children, and for all my own food, including that big huge bird called a "turkey" that I'm going to devour this Thursday! Why not take a few moments today and pray to God, thanking Him for all His blessings, as we get ready for Thanksgiving? Have a "purr"-fect week!


