

St. Andrew was one of the 12 Apostles and suffered martyrdom by crucifixion. We will celebrate our parish feast day at Wednesday's daily Masses at 6:30 a.m. and 8:30 a.m. The 8:30 a.m. Mass will be an "all school Mass."

GIVING TUESDAY is this week! For those who have already made a contribution, THANK YOU! You may recall that the last time we participated in GIVING TUESDAY, you helped us raise more than \$15,000 for the beautiful Malmark handbells, which have become a beautiful addition to our music ministry. This year, we are turning our fundraising efforts toward the Bryce Eck Center.

OUR NEED: The post-pandemic surge in activities has increased demand for space, especially the parish hall. Because we've nearly reached scheduling capacity in the parish hall, we need to take full advantage of the spaces available at the Bryce Eck Center. Unfortunately, some of the equipment and fixtures are in disrepair and must be replaced, including many of the ballroom chairs, the refrigerator and the ice machine.

OUR GOAL: We want to raise \$15,000 to cover the cost of the fixtures and equipment. The parish will match all donations up to \$7,500. Any funds raised beyond our \$15,000 goal will be used to replace the aging freezer and install storage cabinets in the Bryce Eck balcony area.



REAP THE MOST TAX BENEFIT WHILE SUPPORTING ST. ANDREW

ST. ANDREW: Maximize your giving dollars before the ball drops on New Year's Eve by using funds in your retirement account to support St. Andrew Church. The IRA Charitable Rollover allows donors who are 70.5 years or older to transfer up to \$100,000 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation. In doing so, donors keep their IRA distribution from impacting their gross income and possibly avoid being bumped into a higher tax bracket. The IRA charitable rollover can also count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD), which starts at age 72.

All transfers must be made directly from an IRA custodian to The Catholic Foundation by December 15th to qualify as a 2022 rollover and be excluded from the donor's taxable income. 




WELCOME OUR BLESSED MOTHER INTO YOUR HOME
