HOPEFUL ANTICIPATION

WAITING ISN'T EASY. IT IS OFTEN REALLY HARD.

Think of a newly engaged couple, they are so excited to plan a wedding, but as the months go by, they long for the marriage itself.

Advent is like that engagement period; we know the Lord is coming and can see the date coming up ahead. Conversely, the second coming might make us anxious about the future and the waiting since no one but God knows what is happening. But it is in the waiting that the Lord provides his faithfulness.

Think of Mary on Good Friday holding her son in her arms, getting a flashback to that first night she held Jesus in her arms, keeping everything in her heart, seeing him grow up and get splinters from working with Joseph and knowing he'd be nailed to wood one day. St. Paul reminds us to 'rejoice in hope' and never to let our eyes leave Jesus, our Hope.

THE EMMAUS ROAD SCHOLARSHIP FUND is a tax savings scholarship fund for Ohio residents that was approved last year by the State of Ohio. This is a charitable donation that actually gives you a State Tax CREDIT of up to \$1,500 for married joint filers, or up to \$750 for single filers. The credit is worth more than a deduction and reduces your tax liability dollar-for-dollar. A deduction simply reduces your taxable income. Contributions can be made using the Diocese of Columbus' Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund link where you can direct your contribution directly to St. Andrew School tuition assistance. Any Ohio State Tax Payer can participate. You can also use this contribution as a federal tax deduction. Consider taking advantage of this dollar-for-dollar tax credit before the end of the year! **REAP THE MOST TAX BENEFIT WHILE SUPPORTING**

ST. ANDREW: Maximize your giving dollars before the ball drops on New Year's Eve by using funds in your retirement account to support St. Andrew Church. The IRA Charitable Rollover allows donors who are 70.5 years or older to transfer up to \$100,000 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation. In doing so, donors keep their IRA distribution from impacting their gross income and possibly avoid being bumped into a higher tax bracket. The IRA charitable rollover can also count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD), which starts at age 72.

All transfers must be made directly from an IRA custodian to The Catholic Foundation by December 15th to qualify as a 2022 rollover and be excluded from the donor's taxable income.
