## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we celebrate the Fourth Sunday of Advent and the great feast of the Nativity of the Lord is just one week away! The Gospel reading on this Sunday narrates how the angel revealed to Joseph that Mary would bear a son, whom he was to name Jesus, "because he will save his people from their sins."

The Fourth Sunday of Advent emphasizes that the birth of the Savior is near – it is very close – because Mary is with child. The birth of the Son of God as a human being from the Virgin Mary will mean that "God is with us." His birth will be the manifestation of the tender mercy of God toward the human race.

On this Sunday, let us draw strength and be filled with hope and peace, and with the knowledge that our salvation is near.

As you know, Christmas falls on Sunday, Dec. 25, and Christmas Eve is Saturday, Dec. 24. Please note the Masses for the celebration of Christmas are scheduled differently than our regular weekend Mass schedule. There will be **no Confessions on Saturday afternoon, December 24**. The Christmas Eve Masses will be at 4:00 p.m. (in the Church and Parish Hall), 6:00 p.m. and 10:00 p.m. The Christmas Day Masses on Sunday, Dec. 25, are at 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. There is no 7:30 a.m. Mass on Christmas Day. May these days leading up to Christmas be filled with spiritual joy! May God bless you all. The Lord is near!

THE BIBLICAL AND HISTORICAL EVIDENCE FOR CHRIST

### Do you have a New Year's Resolution to enrich your spiritual life?

Consider Bible Study. You will find thought-provoking conversation and great fellowship while

learning a little something about your faith. Join the St. Andrew Tuesday Evening Bible Study Group where we gather Catholics in small group discussions and break open God's word through Bible Study.

Our next nine-week study will be *Lectio: The Case for Jesus* by Dr. Brant Pitre. Can we trust the Gospels? Do we really know who wrote them? Do the Gospels communicate truth – or fabricated fables? Who is Jesus? Who did Jesus claim to be? Dr. Brant Pitre will draw evidence from both early Christian and non-Christian writings attesting to the authenticity, authorship, and dating of the Gospels, and as he gives an in-depth look at the Gospel accounts of Jesus' Crucifixion, Resurrection, and the proclamation of Christ's divinity. Dr. Pitre's powerful presentation will strengthen your faith so that you can not only stand firm and profess that Jesus truly is "the Christ, the Son of the living God," but also confidently respond to any skeptics you encounter.

We meet on Tuesday evenings, 7:15-8:30 p.m., January 10 through March 7, and will use Dr. Pitre's video program and optional (but suggested) workbook during our weekly gatherings. Homework/extra study is optional and up to each person's time commitments and desire. **REAP THE MOST TAX BENEFIT WHILE SUPPORTING ST. ANDREW:** Maximize your giving dollars before the ball drops on New Year's Eve by using funds in your retirement account to support St. Andrew Church. The IRA Charitable Rollover allows donors who are 70.5 years or older to transfer up to \$100,000 from a traditional or Roth IRA to a qualified charity like The Catholic Foundation. In doing so, donors keep their IRA distribution from impacting their gross income and possibly avoid being bumped into a higher tax bracket. The IRA charitable rollover can also count toward your required minimum distribution (RMD), which starts at age 72.

All transfers must be made directly from an IRA custodian to The Catholic Foundation by December 15th to qualify as a 2022 rollover and be excluded from the donor's taxable income. 
