## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Happy Second Sunday of Advent! The season of Advent always goes by much quicker than I would wish.

When I was a child, it seemed to take forever as I waited for Christmas to come, but as an adult, I wish days of Advent would linger a little bit longer so I could enjoy the quiet, peaceful austerity of the Advent days. But that's the problem: the days of Advent leading up to Christmas are not quiet and peaceful – they are busy and hectic, even more so than usual. So I have to try to carve out quiet time during the busy season in order to find some peaceful moments to await the Lord's coming into our midst. I am guessing that your Advent is much the same as mine, so I hope you will also create some quiet moments for yourself to await the Lord in watchful prayer and eager longing.

One of my favorite Advent quiet moments occurs at dawn or dusk. The sky is mostly dark, there are a few stars overhead with streaks of pink and purple hues across the sky, and the bare limbs of trees silhouetted against the sky, I call that an "Advent sky." I think of the Advent hymn, "Creator of the Stars of Night." It is a peaceful and contemplative moment of prayer for me.

I hope you will experience some peaceful prayerful moments in these days of Advent.

**THE EMMAUS ROAD SCHOLARSHIP FUND** is a tax savings scholarship fund for Ohio residents that was approved last year by the State of Ohio. This is a charitable donation that actually gives you a State Tax CREDIT of up to \$1,500 for married joint filers, or up to \$750 for single filers. The credit is worth more than a deduction and reduces your tax liability dollar-for-dollar. A deduction simply reduces your taxable income. Contributions can be made using the Diocese of Columbus' Emmaus Road Scholarship Fund link where you can direct your contribution directly to St. Andrew School tuition assistance. Any Ohio State taxpayer can participate. You can also use this contribution as a federal tax deduction. Consider taking advantage of this dollar-for-dollar tax credit before the end of the year!
