MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Can you believe that it is almost Lent already? This coming Wednesday, February 22, is Ash Wednesday, the first day of Lent. Lent is a season of the Church's year that is approximately six weeks in duration. It is a season of preparation for Easter. We prepare for Easter by doing penance during the "40 days" of Lent.

Jesus was crucified and died on Good Friday and rose again from the dead on Easter Sunday, and in doing so, He revealed the Paschal Mystery to us. We die and rise with Christ in Baptism. We share His victory over sin and death, and even now in this life, we live a new life of virtue with our eyes fixed upon Christ and the things that are above rather than the things of earth.

The Season of Lent was originally the period of final purification and penance for the Catechumens of the Church who were preparing to be baptized into the Paschal Mystery at the Easter Vigil. During Lent, the Catechumens, through repentance and penance, strengthened their intention to be followers of Christ, and purified themselves in preparation for the Sacraments of Initiation. The genuineness of their repentance and the sincerity of their intentions were tested as the Catechumens underwent the "scrutinies." In fact, our Catechumens and candidates preparing to become Catholic here at St. Andrew Parish will undergo this same process during Lent this year. And while they are preparing for Baptism and the Sacraments of Initiation, the rest of us are preparing to renew our baptismal promises and our profession of faith at Easter. We do that in the very same way – through repentance and conversion, and doing penance for our sins. We must turn aside from our sins, root out our bad habits and our attachment to all that is worldly and selfish, and purify our intention to give ourselves completely to Christ. We must love and serve God with a pure and undivided heart, and love our neighbor as ourselves.

So, starting Wednesday, let's get busy and do our Lenten duty, so that when Easter comes, we can renew our Baptism in purity and uprightness of heart. Please pray for one another and support one another along the path of repentance, and especially pray for our RCIA class of Catechumens and candidates.

May God bless you and may you have a holy Lent.





SAINT MONICA BOOK CLUB AT ST. ANDREW



STEWARDSHIP IS A WAY OF LIFE

What we have, we do not own. We are simply the caretakers, which makes it easier to see our responsibility to cultivate, multiply and distribute what we have. 
