MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

"Beware the ides of March!" That is the famous line from Shakespeare's play, Julius Caesar, and was a warning that something dreadful was about to happen that day. The "ides" of March is the middle day of the month – March 15 – which occurs on Wednesday of this week. I hope nothing dreadful happens then, but let's be careful just the same. Not only on the ides of March, but every day of our lives, we should ask God to protect us and our loved ones from all harm, and entrust us to the protection of our guardian angel, whom God has charged to protect us in all our ways.

Friday of this week is another important day – St. Patrick's Day! St. Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland, the "apostle" of Ireland because he brought the Gospel and established the Faith there. Friday, March 17, is also a Friday of Lent, and therefore a day of abstinence from meat. However, a dispensation from the obligation to abstain from meat has been granted by Bishop Fernandes so that those who wish to partake of meat as part of their celebration of St. Patrick's Day, may do so provided they substitute some other penance (see elsewhere in this bulletin for more details.)

St. Patrick's Day is a day for honoring and celebrating Irish heritage. My great grandfather, William Moloney, emigrated from Ireland in the 1840s and settled in Shelby County, Ohio. This was during the Irish Potato Famine. I think the best way to celebrate Irish heritage on St. Patrick's Day is by attending Mass and having potatoes for dinner! No dispensation is needed for that!

May God bless you all and may He hold you in the palm of His hand.

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! It's the Third Sunday of Lent! That's right! During this Season of Lent, I want to keep sharing with you about some of the young "saints" and "blesseds" who are in Heaven to cheer you on as young people who lived totally for God. Lent is a great time to practice more than ever how to be holy and how to get ready for Heaven.



Remember when I meowed to you about Blessed Carlo Acutis? Well, this week, I want to share with you about another young person in Heaven: Blessed Chiara Badano. She was born in 1971 and lived in Italy. She grew up as a normal girl. She liked to hang out with her friends in coffee shops and played sports like tennis and swimming. She liked to sing and dance, and she considered one day becoming a flight attendant. She tried her best at school, but like a lot of kids, she struggled in some subjects, especially math.

As Chiara got older and became a teenager, she grew in her desire to serve Jesus by loving those around her. One of her friends had chicken pox, so, with her parents' permission, Chiara would go and deliver her friend her homework so that her friend would not feel alone while recovering. In her prayer, Chiara offered her suffering and pain in union with the sufferings of Jesus on the Cross. Finally, when it came time for Jesus to bring Chiara to Heaven at the age of 19, Chiara's last words were, "Be happy, because I am." Blessed Chiara is an example of a young person who knew where her ultimate home was located: Heaven! AROUND THE DIOCESE

DISPENSATION FOR ST. PATRICK'S DAY

The obligation to abstain from meat on the Fridays of Lent is an important element of the Church's observance of the penitential nature of this holy season. This year, March 17, the Friday of the Third Week of Lent, corresponds with Saint Patrick's Day, traditionally an occasion for joy-filled celebrations in this diocese, especially among those of Irish heritage. Bishop Fernandes, taking into consideration both past practice and present circumstances, has granted to the faithful of the Diocese of Columbus, as well as to any visitors or travelers who may be physically present within the territory of this diocese, **a dispensation from the obligation of abstinence from meat on March 17, 2023**, provided that the member of the faithful taking advantage of this dispensation, undertakes one of the following works:

- 1) makes a pilgrimage or visit to any church in the Diocese of Columbus named in honor of St. Patrick (Columbus, London, Junction City);
- 2) assists at Mass at any church, chapel, or oratory on March 17;
- 3) prays the "Breastplate of St. Patrick," attributed to St. Patrick;
- 4) engages in some pious devotion such as the Rosary, the Stations of the Cross, or Eucharistic Adoration; or
- 5) performs an act of comparable penance (such as abstinence from meat) on some other occasion during the Third Week of Lent.

All attendees should bring an appetizer or dessert to share with your table. The evening includes a presenter as well as the Divine Mercy Chaplet.
