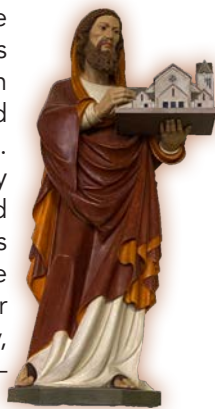
MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This week is the Fourth Sunday of Lent, also called "Laetare Sunday." This marks the middle point of the season of Lent. It is a good time to re-address our Lenten penance and perhaps get back on track if we need to.

Monday of this week (March 20), we observe the Solemnity of St. Joseph. His feast day is actually March 19 but that falls on Sunday this year, so it is transferred to Monday. St. Joseph is the husband of the Blessed Virgin Mary, the foster father of Our Lord, Jesus Christ, and the patron of the Universal Church. Joseph is considered the most important saint after Mary.

Here at St. Andrew Church, we have a large statue of St. Joseph who is shown holding St. Andrew Church in his arms. St. Joseph is often depicted holding the infant Jesus in his arms. The church, of course, is the "body of Christ" of which all the baptized are members. The statue reminds us that St. Joseph is the protector of the Church, just as he was the protector and guardian of Jesus. By the way, St. Joseph is also my patron saint – "Joseph" is my middle name!



May God bless all of you this day, and may the rest of this Lenten season bring you growth in holiness and virtue and many blessings.

THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN

by "Jackie," Fr. Ferguson's Cat

Hi, boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! It's the Fourth Sunday of Lent! That's right! As you know, during the Season of Lent, I've been meowing to you about some of the young "saints" and "blesseds" who are in Heaven to cheer you on as young people who lived totally for God.



So far, I've shared with you about Blessed Carlo Acutis and Blessed Chiara Badano. Well, this week, I want to tell you about another brave young person: Saint Jose Sanchez del Rio. Saint Jose (meowed "ho ZAY") lived in a land not far away from here: Mexico. He was born in 1913 and grew up during a time when we Catholics were being treated very unfairly in Mexico. Sadly, a lot of times in history (and also in some parts of the world even today) Catholics have been persecuted. And young Catholics have had to be really brave to stay true to their faith in Jesus. This was the case for Saint Jose. The government at the time made many laws against Catholics. Jose joined a group to stand up to the government to defend our Catholic faith. The government captured Jose and a lot of his friends and put them into prison. In prison, his captors made Saint Jose watch one of his friends be put to death. This did not deter Jose. He prayed the Rosary and sang hymns and wrote to his mother that he was ready to go to Heaven whenever it might happen.

One day, Saint Jose's captors came to him in prison and led him outside. They cut the skin off the bottoms of his feet (ouch!) and made him walk barefoot toward a cemetery. Along the way, his captors said, "Kid, if you just shout 'Death to Christ the King', we'll let you go!" But Saint Jose refused. He kept shouting, "Long live Christ the King!" Wow! What faith and courage Saint Jose had! Finally, at the cemetery, still refusing to deny Jesus, Saint Jose was killed by his captors. He's an example of how brave a young person can be in the face of immense cruelty and bullying against our faith. He was 15 years old! As a cat, I'll be 15 in a couple of months!

Why not take a few minutes today and meow some prayers to Saint Jose Sanchez del Rio to ask him to help you stay strong no matter how much you get picked on for loving Jesus? Have a "purr"-fect week!
