MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

For this Second Sunday of Lent, I would like to ask you to think about the Stations of the Cross. The "Stations" recall for us Jesus' painful passage along the Via Dolorosa as He carried His cross to Calvary, where He was crucified next to two criminals, and where He died. There are 14 Stations, beginning with Jesus being condemned to death by Pontius Pilate, and ending with His body being laid to rest in the Sepulchre. In between, He encounters His mother, Mary; the weeping women of Jerusalem; Veronica, who wipes His face; and, Simon of Cyrene, who helps Jesus carry His cross. Along the way, Jesus also falls three times beneath the weight of the cross. Yet, He continues to press forward to Golgotha, the place where He will finally die.

I wonder if you have ever noticed how the 14 Stations of the Cross are arranged here in our beautiful St. Andrew Church. The 14 Stations are depicted in stained glass windows on the western wall of the church. There are 14 individual windows. The first Station is toward the rear of the church and the last, or 14th Station, is closer to the altar. The altar is where the sacrifice of Calvary is made present at Mass, so it is fitting that as one prays the Stations, they are going "up to Calvary" just as Jesus did.

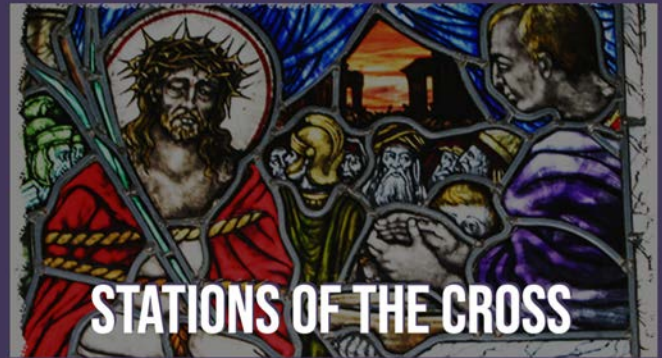
If you look at those 14 windows, you will note that ten of them are on the same level, a bit higher than eye level. But four of the windows are set lower in the wall. The lower windows are the third, seventh, ninth and 14th Stations, representing the three times when Jesus fell to the ground under the weight of the cross, and the final time when His body was laid in the tomb.

In our journey of life, as in our Lenten journey, we must take up our cross and follow after Christ. And like Jesus did, we will fall under the weight of our cross multiple times. We may fall because of illness or misfortune; we may fall because of temptation and selfishness; we may fall because of despair and hopelessness. Even when this happens, we must imitate Jesus and take up our cross again and press forward, keep going. We must never give in to despair and discouragement, but trust in Jesus to raise us up, for He knows what it is like to fall under the weight of the cross.

May God give you strength and courage as you continue your Lenten journey.

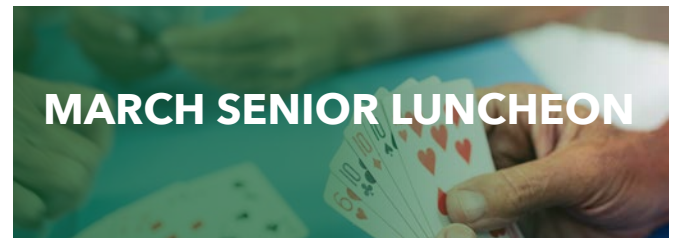


EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION

Hi boys and girls! My name is "Jackie," and, as you know, I am Father Ferguson's cat! It's the Second Sunday of Lent! That's right! As I meowed last week, that means we want to practice more than ever how to be holy and how to get ready for Heaven! I said last week that during this Season of Lent, I would share with you about some of the young "saints" and "blesseds" who are in Heaven to cheer you on as young people who lived totally for God.



But today, I want to meow about some other great role models for being holy young people. They are not in Heaven yet, but they are still growing up and striving to be totally holy. They are the St. Andrew School and PSR eighth-grade students who are receiving their Sacrament of Confirmation today! That's right! AROUND THE DIOCESE

Dispensation for St. Patrick's Day



The obligation to **ABSTAIN FROM MEAT** on the **FRIDAYS OF LENT** is an **IMPORTANT ELEMENT** of the **CHURCH'S OBSERVANCE** of the **PENITENTIAL NATURE** of this **HOLY SEASON**.



This year, **MARCH 17, THE FRIDAY OF THE 3RD WEEK OF LENT**, corresponds with **SAINT PATRICK'S DAY**, traditionally an occasion for joy-filled celebrations in this diocese, especially among those of Irish heritage.

BISHOP EARL K. FERNANDES grants the faithful in the Diocese of Columbus a **DISPENSATION FROM THE ABSTINENCE OF MEAT ON MARCH 17, ST. PATRICK'S DAY, AS LONG AS** they undertake one of the following conditions:



- 1) **MAKES A PILGRIMAGE** or visit to any church in the **DIOCESE OF COLUMBUS** named in honor of **ST. PATRICK** (Columbus, London, Junction City)
- 2) **ASSISTS AT MASS** at any church, chapel, or oratory **ON MARCH 17TH**
- 3) prays the "**BREASTPLATE OF ST. PATRICK**," attributed to St. Patrick
- 4) engages in some pious devotion such as the **ROSARY, THE STATIONS OF THE CROSS, OR EUCHARISTIC ADORATION**
- 5) **PERFORMS AN ACT OF COMPARABLE PENANCE** (such as abstinence from meat) on some other occasion during the Third Week of Lent.
