## MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Alleluia! The Lord is Risen! Alleluia! He is risen indeed!

On this Easter day, I greet you all with the ancient acclamation of joy and praise, "Alleluia!" This exclamation expresses the joy and wonder of those first disciples who heard the joyful news that the Lord Jesus had risen and was alive and had appeared to His friends. Those same disciples had been mournful and downcast following Jesus' brutal death and burial, but their sorrow was turned into ebullient joy when they heard the news "He is risen." They were even incredulous with sheer joy. After all, no one thought it was possible for someone to rise from the dead. So, confronted with the reality of Jesus' victory over death, what else can one say but "Alleluia!" This is how the church still proclaims the miraculous good news of the Resurrection: Alleluia, He is Risen!

This proclamation is still as new and real and true, yet hard to believe, as when those first disciples declared it on the morning of the third day after Jesus' death. And so we should respond to this in the same way – with effusive joy, with faith that overcomes our incredulity, with the joyful shout of "Alleluia."

On behalf of the clergy and staff of St. Andrew Parish, I want to wish one and all, including those who are grieving the recent loss of a loved one, a most blessed and happy Easter.

## THOUGHTS FOR OUR PARISH CHILDREN


