MESSAGE FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend, we welcome Fr. Albeen Vatti to St. Andrew Parish. He is here to make an appeal for the support of the missionary efforts in the Diocese of Warangal, India. I hope you will welcome him and learn from him about the needs of this mission territory, and that you will be generous in your response to the special collection. Thank you for your generosity.

Next week, on Tuesday, Aug. 8, there is a special election in the State of Ohio. There is only one issue on the ballot, "Issue 1." Issue 1 is a proposal that, if passed, would require that proposed amendments to the Ohio Constitution would require approval by 60% of those voting in order to pass. The current requirement is a simple majority (50% plus one vote). Because Issue 1 is not a moral issue, the Bishops of Ohio have remained neutral on the Issue other than to urge all Catholics to fulfill their responsibility of faithful citizenship and vote their conscience. Thus, Catholics are free to vote for or against Issue 1, however you may choose.

In considering how you will vote, something to think about is the effect that the outcome of Issue 1 will have on the November election. There is a proposed constitutional amendment on the November ballot that, if passed, would enshrine abortion rights in the Ohio Constitution. As you already know, our Ohio Bishops have called upon all Catholics to pray and work to defeat this proposed amendment which, if passed, would endanger the lives of the preborn and diminish parental rights. As Catholics, we are obliged to do all we can to defeat this proposal. Something to consider is this: If Issue 1 passes in August, it will be more difficult for the proposed constitutional amendment to protect abortion rights to pass in November. That is only one consideration regarding Issue 1 and there are many others to consider also. No matter what you decide, please vote on August 8, and let us continue to pray and work to defeat the proposed abortion rights amendment in November.

I hope you are getting acquainted with our new Parochial Vicar Fr. Lawrence Tabi! He is getting settled and accustomed to the routine here at St. Andrew Parish. Because he also serves as chaplain to the Ghanaian Catholic Community and serves at St. Aloysius Parish, he is not often visible on Sunday mornings at St. Andrew. But in time you will get to know him and like him! I warned Fr. Tabi that the quiet routine he is getting used to here at St. Andrew will soon be shattered! That's because the Festival at St. Andrew is coming on August 18 and 19! I told him there will be thousands of people, bright lights, loud music, laughing children, carnival rides, and a throng of happy people having a great time right up to midnight – right outside his rectory quarters! I also told him that he will have a lot of fun at the Festival and meet many great people – our St. Andrew parishioners. So both of us are looking forward to this year's festival, and to seeing all of you there in just about three weeks!

May God bless all of you and keep you safe always!

RCIA WILL KICK-OFF THIS FALL: Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) is a process through which non-baptized men and women enter the Catholic Church. It includes several stages marked by study, prayer, and rites at Mass. Participants in RCIA are known as catechumens. They undergo a conversion process as they study the Gospel, profess faith in Jesus and the Catholic Church, and receive the Sacraments of Christian Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. The RCIA process follows the ancient practice of the Church and was restored by the Second Vatican Council as the proper way adults prepare for Baptism.



Ohio's Educational Choice (EdChoice) Scholarship Program is now accessible to **ALL Ohioans!** Thanks to sweeping changes outlined in HB 33 and signed into law on July 3 by Governor DeWine, **EVERY** student now has the opportunity to attend a participating Catholic school for **little or no cost**.

Originally enacted in 2005 to serve families living in underperforming school districts, the program has been expanded multiple times over the past 18 years to aid more families, particularly those with lower incomes. But, now, every Ohio family - regardless of their residence or household income - can utilize state scholarship dollars to help fund tuition at the Catholic **school of their choosing.**

What does this mean for you?

Simply, an **affordable** and **unapologetically Catholic** education is right at your fingertips!

Families at 450% or below of the Federal Poverty Guideline will receive the maximum scholarship allowed by law. Those at 451% or more will receive a portion of the full scholarship amount, dependent on their household income and family size.



Scan to Determine Your Family's Eligibility!

Qualify for EdChoice Traditional AND Expansion?

Families in our diocese living in an underperforming school district who previously qualified for the Traditional EdChoice scholarship now have the option to choose the one that provides the greatest financial benefit to them.

Under the new Expansion guidelines, if their Federal Poverty Guideline results in a scholarship less than the maximum amount of a Traditional Scholarship, the Traditional Scholarship will provide a greater financial benefit. In addition, the family will not need to submit any income verification, unless they qualify for low-income status (200% or below the Federal Poverty Guideline). Contact your school for further clarification.

- 1 Reach out to your school(s) to get started or visit <https://bit.ly/ohioedchoice>.
- 2 Complete a **Scholarship Request Form** for EACH eligible student in grades K-12 who is enrolled in Our Catholic Schools. Submit the request form, as well as a copy of the **student's birth certificate** and **current proof of address** (see scholarship request form for accepted documents) to the appropriate school(s) for submission via the online application system.
- 3 Complete the **income verification process** at <https://safe.ode.state.oh.us/portal>. An OH|ID is required for online submission.


The deadline to request scholarships for this academic year and receive the entire amount for which the family qualifies is **October 14, 2023**. Any application received after this date will be awarded at a pro-rated amount by the Department of Education and Workforce.

*Families who previously were approved for an EdChoice Expansion Scholarship for the 2023-24 school year need to do nothing at this time. Your scholarship will be updated automatically based on the new scholarship amounts.

EdChoice: Empowering Parents Today for the Future

The Ohio Educational Choice (EdChoice) Scholarship Program provides students throughout the State of Ohio the opportunity to attend participating private schools for **little or no cost**. Enacted in 2005 to serve families living in underperforming school districts, the program has since expanded to provide **increased opportunities** to all Ohio families with scholarships up to \$6,165 for K-8 and \$8,407 for grades 9-12.

Due to the recent changes in the state's biennial budget, families 450% or below of the Federal Poverty Guideline are eligible for the full EdChoice scholarship amount. Families above 450% will be eligible for a portion of the scholarship, dependent on their income and family size.



What are Federal Poverty Guidelines?

The poverty guidelines are a simplified version of the statistical thresholds used by U.S. Census Bureau for calculating the number of people in poverty. Poverty guidelines are issued each year in the **Federal Register** by the U.S. Department of Health & Human Services to **determine financial eligibility** for certain programs and vary by family size. In 2023, a family of four (4) at 450% of the Federal Poverty Guideline has a **gross income** of \$135,000/year.



The Catechism of the Catholic Church clearly states, "Parents have the first responsibility for the education of their children," and, "As those first responsible for the education of their children, parents have the right to choose a school for them which corresponds to their own convictions. The right is fundamental."

Making a high-quality, unapologetically Catholic education affordable for families is one of the foremost priorities for the Diocese of Columbus.
